


SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR:

Jim Miller 987 Dead Indian Mem. Road Ashland, Oregon 97520

LOCATION:

Sections 4 and 9, Township 37 South, Range 1 East



PURPOSE:

To partition TL. No.201-37-1E-9 and T.L. No.400-37-1E-4 into three parcels.

PROCEDURE:

Bearing and coordinate data was taken from found traverse control monuments of Recorded Survey No. 13281, from which the new parcel boundaries were located according to the clients instructions and zoning requirements.

The East and South boundaries of parcel no. 3 in section 9 were not determined nor monumented. A portion of the boundary between parcels no. 1 and 2 in section 4 were determined but not monumented.

Antelope Road right of way in section 4 could not be determined exactly due to destroyed centerline monuments. During the 1981 County paving project, 60 penny spikes were set at centerline P.I. Stations 575+61.9 and 581+32.8. The original 3/4" iron pin at Sta. 586+77.1 was apparently destroyed by said paving project.

These two spikes were tied to along with the found 5/8" iron pins per Recorded Survey No. 3098 along the Southerly right of way. These found monuments are at variance from 1 to 2 feet, more or less.

Therefore, for acreage purposes, I established the approximate right of way as shown on the accompanying plat by projecting the centerline at record distance and delta angle northwesterly from the found 3/4" iron pin at centerline P.I. Station 598+04.3.
