NARRATIVE REPORT

Survey for Rev. D. E. Millard

Sec. 15, T. 34 S. R. 1 W. Shady Cove, Oregon.

Purpose of Survey

To establish the northerly and easterly boundary of proterty conveyed to Floyd Kelley. The original description of the north line projected that line through an existing home and the line was changed by agreement to avoid damage to the property bordering on the North.

Proceedure.

An original survey of the South boundary had been made by J. H. Clabby and his map was furnished to be used as a basis for this survey.

Four pipe corners of the Clabby survey were found and certified and the remaining lines run out and the north line agreed upon by the owners. Bearings were based on those lines as run by Clabby.

The highway line was run in conformance with pips monuments on property to the north and distances checked through to the south line of Government Lot 5 at the southwest corner of the Gulbertson property at a concrete monument.
