

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Survey for:

Location: A replat of Parcels 1 and 2 of minor land partition recorded in Volume 5 at Page 189 and Parcels 1, 3 and 4 and a portion of Parcel 2 of minor land partition recorded in Volume 10 at Page 7 of "Minor Land Partitions" in Jackson County, Oregon, in the Northwest One-Quarter (1/4) of Section 14, Township 39 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, City of Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon.

<u>Purpose</u>: To survey, monument and prepare plat for a land partition and a property line adjustment per City of Ashland Planning Action No. 97-074 and per client's request.

Procedure: Utilizing found monuments from filed Survey Numbers 9668, 10076, 10549, 11809 and 11447 for control, I established monuments as shown on the accompanying map. The railroad right-ofway controversy, concerning the right-of-way width on each side of the centerline of the existing tracks, is still an area of question. The existing recorded deeds indicate a right-of-way width of 50 feet each side of the centerline of the tracks. Previously, in other locations, Southern Pacific Railroad has claimed and prevailed that they own 100 feet on each side of the centerline of the existing tracks. The right-of-way line at 50 feet from centerline of tracks as shown on filed Surveys No. 3840 and 9846 indicates monuments at the line 50 feet from centerline of tracks and the minor land partitions that are a part of this replat also indicate the Southwesterly boundary as the same line. as shown on the accompanying plat, a right-of-way, in favor of the Central Oregon and Pacific Railroad Company (Successor in interest to the Oregon and California Railroad Company) and/or the United States by reason of the Act of Congress, dated July 25, 1866, as disclosed by deed to Central Oregon and Pacific Railroad Company, recorded April 9, 1996 as Instrument No. 96-22818 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon. It is not the intent of this survey to try and resolve this issue, but to show existing conditions. As in previous situations of this nature, some sort of agreement needs to be reached or settled between the railroad company and my client to end this controversy.

Bearing: N.O.A.A. True Meridian at North-South centerline of Section 14 as derived from N.O.A.A. Survey Net established in 1968 and filed in the Office of the Jackson County Surveyor. Bearing reference line taken from filed Survey No. 9668 as shown hereon.
