

Location:

West half of the southeast one-quarter of Section 18, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Basis of Bearing:

Record of Survey No. 7989, Solar Observation

Purpose:

To locate the northeast and northwest corner points Tax Lots 700 and 800 and to mark the property lines separating Tax Lots 600,700 and 800.

Procedure:

I began this survey with the recovery of the monuments established during Record of Survey No. 7989 by Richard L. Templin, PLS No. 1354, dated August 21, 1979. I recovered the ½ corner to sections 18 and 19, the east 1/16th corner to sections 18 and 19, the center ½ corner of section 18 and the center-east 1/16th corner to section 18.

With the controlling corners identified I performed a series of survey traverse lines tying to each of the controlling corners. I then utilized the deed descriptions for the three parcels and computed the partition lines and established the corner points as shown on the attached map. East-west lines along the north boundaries of Tax Lots 700 and 800 were posted with metal posts at random intervals and trees along the line were blazed.
