PURPOSE:

To locate and monument the boundaries of the parcels as described in

Instrument numbers 95-34123, 94-38285 and 75-15454 of the Deed

Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE

Using a Wild T-1000 total station, a control traverse was established through the subject area, tying found monuments and fence lines (etc.). Field data was analyzed and boundaries were monumented as shown on the attached plat.

As discussed in the narrative of Filed Survey 10601, the alignment of Scenic Avenue lying west of Highway 99 has been historically held to the 1910 Road Survey monumentation and designated as 60 foot wide. Research at Jackson County Road Department verified this, as well as the shown alignment for Grant Road, however no specific width was found for the latter. County policy has been to adopt a 60 foot right of way when none has been stated.

It should be noted that pertinent deeds do not specifically a call to Scenic Avenue and the parcels were originally broken out as part of Coakley Donation Land Claim No. 51, which was bounded on the north by the section line between sections 33 and 4. Therefore boundary determinations were made using the section line as control, but the right of way line per the 1910 Road Survey was monumented as the north boundary. The remaining boundaries were monumented per deed record.
