

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 205.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

**PURPOSE:** 

At the direction of the County Commissioners, to locate and monument the

northwesterly boundary of the subject property.

PROCEDURE:

The subject property was first described in Instrument No. 66-01783 of the official records of Jackson County, recorded in February, 1966. All

subsequent deeds, including the latest deed, Instrument No. 94-17235, describe the

boundary with identical wording.

The deed description commences at the southwest corner of Section 9, and calls for a bearing of North a required distance, and then a call East to the highway right of way. In order to determine bearing orientation, solar readings were taken. The resulting bearing compared very precisely with the solar bearing determined by Survey No. 4975, when comparing bearings between the monument at said section corner and the 3/4" iron pin found from said filed survey.

To determine the right of way boundary of Old Highway 99, a series of measurements were taken along the existing yellow striped centerline. The record constructed centerline, as shown on State Highway Map No. F-5-6 (CS #102/8), "KLAMATH FALLS JUNC. TO CALIFORNIA STATE LINE, PACIFIC HIGHWAY" dated May, 1927, was computed and oriented to these measurements. Holding record highway bearings, a surprisingly tight fit resulted at the extreme far ends of the centerline measurements. From this, it was evident that the roadbed in the vicinity of the 54° curve, in front of the subject property, had subsequently been widened easterly in order to flatten the sharp centerline curve. Road construction work is underway at the present time, which appears to be widening the roadbed farther east to flatten the curve even more.

Measurements were taken along the centerline of the railroad tracks in order to determine where the northwesterly boundary of the subject property meets the northeasterly boundary of the railroad right of way.
