## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

To survey and monument Old England Estates, a subdivision as approved by the City of Phoenix Planning Commission, File No. SUB 98-2.

Procedure:

Control was utilized as established by this office in the performance of this and other surveys. The monuments shown hereon were established from this control. The boundary established by Survey No. 15888 attempted to resolve the conflict between the right of way of Colver Road to the south of this project and the right of way created by Jackson County Roads and Parks as depicted on Survey No. 14941 and described by Instrument No. 93-10836 located in the Official Records of Jackson County. The confusion is a result of multiple PI monuments as depicted on Survey No. 15888. It is this surveyor's determination that the original 60 foot right of way, being 30 feet on each side of the depicted center line and its intersection with the right of way created by the County in 1993 intersects 32.68 feet north of the southwest corner of Lot 24. The southerly found monument from Survey No. 14941 falls within the original 60 foot right of way.

#### Declaration:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we Bilyeu Construction, Inc. are the owners of the lands hereon described, and that we have subdivided the same into lots and streets as shown hereon and size of the lots and the lengths of all lines are plainly set forth, and that this plat is a correct representation of the Subdivision, and we do hereby dedicate to the public for public use, the public utility easements and streets shown hereon and to the City of Phoenix the easement shown hereon as side of the construct and the constru maintain said storm drain. We hereby grant the private storm drain easements as shown hereon for the benefit of the adjoining lots within the subdivision as shown hereon. We hereby designate said Subdivision as Old England Estates.


