


Bursell Road (the East boundary of D.L.C. No. 54) that I develop overages on the North boundary of Lot 8, (measure 305.16811'), (PLAT=3'4.3') (calc. from SN 7820=304.27') and on the South boundary of Lot 6 (measure=305.121') (plat=304.3') (calc. from SN 7820=304.72').

I held the centerline monuments on PITTVIEW AVENUE as set or used on SYDNEY ESTATES SUBD., FOREST GLEN - PHASE III, Filed Survey No. 13653, Filed Survey No. 14351, and other surveys as shown on the accompanying map. As is also shown on the accompanying map by extending PITTVIEW AVENUE West to Bursell Road this will come into the East right-of-way line of Bursell Road Ø.48' Southerly from a proportionate location for the NW corner of Lot 5 and SW corner of Lot 6. The procedure of holding the existing monumented centerline of PITTVIEW AVENUE was used because several irregularities have been found in existing surveys as they relate to the amended PITT VIEW Plat which makes holding strictly to a proportion, especially when a proportion could cause an angle point in the centerline of PITTVIEW AVENUE, not to be acceptable.

The new adjusted boundaries were located per the client's direction and as approved by the City of Central Point.

PROCEDURE:

Several of the lots in the amended

Pitt View Plat were monumented on Filed Survey Nos. 7820 and 10609. These surveys also show computed boundaries with no monumentation on other lots. There have been lots in said Plat partitioned and subdivided using controls established on said surveys 7820 and 10609, therefore I held monuments and controls established on said surveys 7820 and 10609 to locate the North boundary of Lot 8 and the East boundaries of Lots 6, 7 and 8 because these monuments and controls represent the accepted configuration of the interior lot lines of the Plat. I also find by locating the Westerly boundaries of said Lots $\bar{\text{6}}$, 7 and 8, 30.00 feet Easterly from the centerline of
