PROCEDURE: UTILIZING A WILD T.C. 1010 TOTAL STATION,
A CLOSED TRAVERSE WAS RUN TYING FOUND MONUMENTS AND GOVERNMENT
CORNERS AS SHOWN. A R/W CENTERLINE WAS ESTABLISHED AND ACCEPTED
BY THE ABOVE MENTIONED BOARD ORDER. R/W MONUMENTS WERE
SET AT RIGHT ANGLES TO CENTERLINE UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

BASIS OF BEARING: THE CENTERLINE OF PACIFIC
AVENUE BETWEEN THE MONUMENTS AT ITS INTERSECTIONS
WITH ANTELOPE ROAD AND AVENUE "A" (ABANDONED)

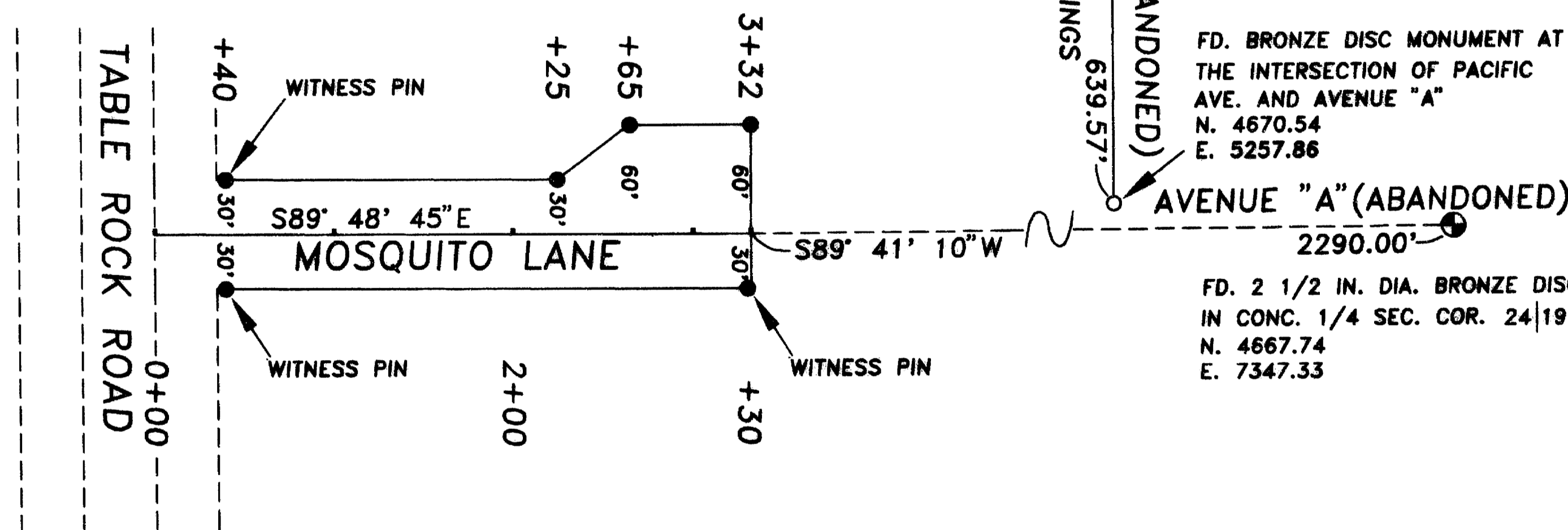
