LOCATION:

In Lot 8 of Block 3 of MEDFORD HEIGHTS ADDITION to the City of Medford and in Lots 8 & 9 of IMPERIAL ADDITION to the City of Medford, being situated in the City of Medford, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

MAP OF SURVEY: To locate and monument the boundaries of Tax Lot 3700 as shown on the accompanying map and to prepare a 'Map of Survey' for filing.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing the found monuments as shown, existing control data per S.N. 10712 in the possession of this office and the City of Medford Fieldbooks #295 & #1523, computed the Location of the South edge of the 3/4 inch iron pin at the intersection of Ashland Avenue and East Main. A proportional equation was developed to correspond to the city's retracement. This equation was used to compute the Easterly end of Smith Street using Plat record and holding the computed location of the South edge of the previously mentioned 3/4 inch iron pin. This solution best fits the solutions provided on Survey Number 1955, Survey Number 10712, Survey Number 3173 and the city's retracement of Willamette Avenue. The alignment of Ashland Avenue was held as that determined on Survey Number 1955 and Survey Number 10712. The centerline of Willamette Avenue and Ninth Street were determined from the City of Medford Fieldbooks previously mentioned. Block 3 of MEDFORD HEIGHTS ADDITION to the City of Medford was then computed using plat record for distance along Ashland Street since the Plat gives no distance along the East line of Lot 8. The boundaries of Volume 325, Page 447, Deed Records for Jackson County, Oregon were then computed and monumented as shown. The Northerly Right of Way line of Ninth Street was held at 30 feet from the computed centerline derived from City of Medford Fieldbook #1523, Page 2. Monuments set on this survey consist of 5/8" x 30" steel pins with red plastic caps mkd. "R. BRAUGHTON - LS 2657".
