



NARRATIVE

PURPOSE: To survey the SE and SW 1/16 corners of Section 18, per my clients request.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing filed survey number 11288, I made necessary ties to corners set and found on filed survey number 11288. I computed the SE and SW 1/16 positions and set as shown on accompanying map.

At the SE 1/16 corner of Section 18, I set:

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which the following bearing trees:

- A Madrone, 13" diameter bears N 63° E, 9.0 feet, scribed "SE1/16" "BT".
- A Black Oak, 20" diameter bears N 10° E, 21.7 feet, scribed "SE1/16" "BT".

At the Sw 1/16 corner of Section 18, I set:

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which the following bearing trees:

- A Douglas Fir, 10" diameter bears S 9° W, 23.6 feet, scribed "SW1/16" "BT".
- A Douglas Fir, 12" diameter bears N 69° W, 4.2 feet, scribed "SE1/16" "BT".
