LOCATION:

Situated in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section

3, Township 37 South, Range 2 East, Willamette Meridian and Base,

Jackson County Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey and partition, in conformance with the approved tentative plan, that tract of land conveyed in the deed to the Oscar W. Swanson Living Trust recorded October 3, 1991 in Document Number 91-23984

in the Official Records, Jackson County Oregon.

BASIS OF

BEARINGS:

Found axle and found 3/4" iron pipe as West per filed survey number

976 prepared by Edward McGinty, April 8, 1957.

PROCEDURE: The land described in Document Number 91-23984 is a portion of Lot 1 of Amy's Cottage Addition to Central Point and describes a larger parcel with exceptions, the resultant land conveyed being the larger parcel minus the exception.

A search of the County Surveyor's records yielded three previous filed surveys in the area of concern: FS 248 prepared by C.Z. Boyden, February, 1950; FS 976 prepared by Edward McGinty, April 8, 1957; and FS 4991-A prepared by Hugh C. Ingle, October 15, 1972. These three surveys are in basic agreement except for the direction of the southerly line of the aforesaid Lot 1. FS 248 established the line by holding the found monument at the S.E. 1/16 corner and a distance of 1328.2 from the found monument at the S. 1/4 corner while FS 976 held the same monument at the S.E. 1/16 corner and found monument at the S.C. 1/16 corner. Even so the resultant bearings differ by only 45". FS 4991-A accepted the monuments as shown on FS 976 for said southerly line and proceeded accordingly. In retracing the land conveyed by document number 91-23984 this survey has relied upon FS 976 and FS 4991-A.

A found 2" diameter axle with a brass center was found and accepted as the S.E. 1/16 corner and it is assumed to be the same monument described as a "38" iron pin" on FS 248, as a "2" brass Cap Pipe" on FS 976, and as a "Brass Disc" on FS 4991-A. A found 1" diameter axle

located a deed record 199 feet from the accepted 1/16 corner monument was accepted as the point of beginning of the subject deed and assumed to be the same monument shown as an iron pin on FS 248. A search for the center east 1/16 corner monument as shown on FS 248 and FS 976 yielded nothing and it is assumed that the monument was destroyed by the placement of a utility pole very near the calculated position. A found 3/4" iron pipe 355 feet west of the point of beginning was accepted as the N.E. corner of the lands conveyed by the subject deed and is assumed to be the same monument shown as set on FS 976 and "called for" in the adjoining deed, Document Number 96-05804. A found 5/8" iron pin at the S.E. corner, assumed to be set per FS 4991-A, was accepted for the line of the southerly line of the lands conveyed by the subject deed but was found to be off for the westerly line. This monument possibly could have been disturbed by the construction of the existing or previous fences. The other monument set on that line per FS 4991-A was searched for but not found and assumed to be destroyed. A 5/8 rebar and plastic cap stamped, "Alspach PLS 2653" was placed at the S.E. corner of the lands conveyed at the intersection of the southerly line with the easterly line.

In the course of the survey a gap was discovered existing between the easterly line of Amy's Cottage Addition to Central Point as monumented by the filed surveys previously cited and the westerly line of the Plat of Central Point, 1887 as monumented by found street centerline monuments. Additionally, no record right of way dedication could be found for the physical improvements of North Second Street which is located within this gap. This condition is noted and shown upon the Partition Plat but no attempt has been made to resolve this issue.


