


The Southwesterly boundary of tract described in Inst. No. 39-23842 O.R. was located record distance, 136.20', Northeasterly from monuments set on Filed Survey No. 7466 and also used for control on Shasta Meadows. The Northeasterly boundary of said tract was located per monuments found or set on Filed Survey No. 3117 and at right angles from Shasta Avenue.

PURPOSE:

Boundary Survey of tracts described in Instrument No. 99-21469 O.R. and Tract "A" of Inst. No. 86-19531 O.R.

PROCEDURE:

The centerline of Shasta Avenue was

located from centerline monuments of record. The South boundary of DLC No. 45 was calculated from previous surveys by this office and further substantiated by data on Filed Survey No. 7466. The County Surveyor monumented for the NE corner of DLC No. 46 was destroyed by sewer line construction and was not reset as of the time of our field work.

The Plat of Shasta Meadows shows finding ½" iron pipe monuments on the common boundary with Filed Survey No. 3117 (the Northeasterly bdry. of Shasta Meadows) and accepted the found monuments as property corners. We find another $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe on a corner of Filed Survey No. 3117 and accept it as being a controlling point for the Northeasterly boundary of Tract "A" as described in Inst. No. 86-19531 O.R. We also find this ½" iron pipe agrees with Northerly ½" pipe shown on Shasta Meadows, 103.11 feet apart, which equals record per Filed Survey No. 3117.
