




A 9 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N65°15'E, 19.5 feet, marked T33SR3ES15 in upper face, BT in lower face.

An 11.5 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S14°45'E, 31.1 feet marked T33SR3ES22 in upper face, BT in lower face.

A 7.5 inch diameter White Fir bears S9°04'W, 61.5 feet marked T33SR3ES21 in upper face, BT in lower face.

A 7 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N80°10'W, 74.4 feet marked T33SR3ES16 in upper face, BT in lower face.

NEW TREES MARKED AT THE SECTION CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 8, 9, 15, AND 16 TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST.

TheNorthwest, Southeast, and Southwest bearing trees, which had been marked by the Jackson County Surveyor in 1976,had been cut during logging operations. New trees were marked to replace these trees. At the corner point I found a 2 ½" diameter Jackson County Brass Cap.

FROM WHICH:

A 16.5 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N39°25'W, 52.8 feet marked T33SR3ES8 in upper face, BT in lower face.

A 20.5 inch diameter White Fir bears S4°52'E, 26.1 feet marked T33SR3ES16 in upper face, BT in lower face.

A 13 inch diameter Sugar Pine bears S87°11'W, 26.4 feet marked T33SR3ES17 in upper face, BT in lower face.



BASIS OF BEARING:

Solar observation near the Southwest corner of Section 16.

PURPOSE:

To survey, mark, and post property lines of Superior Lumber Company and Indian Hills Limited Partnership land as shown on the map to accompany this narrative.

PROCEDURE:

A search of records revealed that the corners needed for control of this survey had been re-established from original evidence. The Section corner common to Section 15, 16, 21, and 22 had not been re-established. A search in the field revealed a 1 3/4" iron pipe set by Ernest Smith as the approxamite location of said corner, no original evidence of the corner could be found.

A closed traverse was run tying to the corners needed for control. The position of the Section corner common to section 15, 16, 21, and 22 was calculated by double proportionate measurement. Then the monument was set and lines were marked as shown on the map to accompany this narrative.

CORNERS SET THIS SURVEY:

All measurements to bearing trees are to the center of tree at base. All bearing trees have a Brass washer marked PLS 1086 nailed to lower face.

Section corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21, and 22, Township 33 South Range 3 East. At the corner point I set a 5/8 by 30 inch iron pin with a 2" diameter Aluminum cap marked:

> T33S R3E 16 15 21 22 PLS 1086

FROM WHICH:
