



## SURVEY NARRATIVE

PURPOSE: To establish a line SOUTH from the West 1/16th corner as placed by Survey No. 11986 and to locate the existing barn in relation to said SOUTH line.

Procedure: To determine the meridian, I locate and measure between a 3/4 inch iron pipe, marking the Southwest corner of Lot 13, Blk. 2 of HIGHLAND MEADOWS SUB. and the 5/8 inch rebar marking the West 1/16th corner per said Sur. No. 11986. Both Sur. No. 11986 and HIGHLAND MEADOWS SUB. indicate these points to be on the Section line.

I then measure to the two most northerly corners of the barn and then set two rebar along a line I determine to be SOUTH from said West 1/16th corner. The plat shows the calculated position of the barn with respect to the section line and the established line.
