

## PROCEDURE:

This survey proceeded by locating the monuments at the Southwest and Southeast corners of DLC 45 to establish the deed call point of commencement and basis of bearings. The bearing of S 89°47'22" E was adopted for this line in order to conform to the three existing surveys in this area: FS 6675, FS 9375, and FS 14859. A deed record distance of 623.40 was held along this line. From this point the survey proceeded to the point of beginning by accepting and holding FS 14859 for the position of Oregon and Frances Streets. It should be noted that since DN 90-00443 and V. 456 P. 45(Oregon Street) have identical calls, this survey assumes the intent of the deed is to commence to the northerly line or Oregon Street and along said northerly line to the point of beginning. From the point of beginning the survey continued along the northerly line of Oregon Street to the deed call easterly line of V. 230 P. 309 along a bearing provided by holding the deed record angle from V. 456 P. 45. The easterly line of V. 230 P. 309 is a senior line, the line being first established by the deed from Bowers to Manwaring recorded 1913 in V. 95 P. 576 of Deed Records. Bowers later deeded the lands lying easterly of this line to Becker by deed recorded 1932 in V. 192 P. 543, Deed Records. Both of these deeded parcels were part of larger 25.83 acre tract deeded to Bowers from Stephenson in 1908 by deed recorded in V. 71 P.99, Deed Records. The location of this senior line as established by FS 6675 was adopted and held by this survey. DN 90-00443 then proceeds along this easterly to the most southerly corner of the tract described in V. 429 P. 271, Deed Records. This survey adopted and held the southerly line of FS 9375 as the southerly line of V. 429 P. 271 but did not accept the most southerly corner of said survey as being the intended corner of V. 429 P. 271. In determining its easterly line, FS 9375 held the deed call of 306.0 feet from the westerly line of Walker Avenue to establish the northeast corner. By doing this FS 9375 shortened the record deed distance along Siskiyou Boulevard from the point of commencement to the point of beginning by 6 feet and created a gap. Deed descriptions in V.95 P. 576, V. 230 P. 309, and V. 429 P. 271 all have identical calls to this point (the northeast corner). Its my opinion that the intent of V. 429 P. 271 is to place the northeast corner on the easterly line of V. 95 P. 576 (later V.230 P. 309). This survey resolved this problem by accepting and holding the southerly line of FS 9375 as the southerly line of V. 429 F. 271 and established the northeast corner of DN 90-0044 3 at the intersection of the southeasterly prolongation of said southerly line with the easterly line of V. 230 P. 309 as previously established. From this point the northwest corner of DN 90-00443 was established at the intersection of the southerly line of FS 9375 with the easterly line of Frances Street as established by FS 14359.

There are deck encroachments from the apartment building along the easterly line which have been shown and detailed on the Map of Survey.
