SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH NO. 269.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Survey For: Susan and Olivier Logeais 104 South Front St. Talent, Or. 97540

Location:

Northwest one-quarter of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Or.

Basis of Bearing:

Record Survey No. 13555

Purpose:

To monument the exterior boundaries of the tracts/parcels described within Deed 86-18709.

Procedure:

I performed a survey traverse tying corner monuments referenced within record surveys No. 1035, 13555, 14093 and the Plat of the Town of Talent (July 1889). From this data, I computed the position and established the monuments as shown on the attached map of survey.

Surveyor David A. Edwards, P.L.S. No. 2339 performed Survey Number 13555 for the Urban Renewal Agency of the City of Talent. During that survey Sorveyor Edwards established an angle point monument to mark the alignment of South Front Street between Wagner and Main Streets. This monument had been destroyed by road construction/maintenance, apparently by the City of Talent Public Works department. Upon further evaluation of the position of this corner I concluded that Surveyor Edwards had incorrectly positioned this monument southerly by 30.00 feet. Apparently Surveyor Edwards failed to include the southerly portion of the Main Street right-of-way or to allow for the number of lots within Block J of the City of Talent Plat. I consulted with Jackson County Surveyor Roger R. Roberts who concurred with my findings. I reestablished the angle point monument at right angles to the northeast line of Block J and 15.00 feet from the southeast corner of Block J. I also recovered an unrecorded monument marking the northeast corner of Tax Lot No. 600 which confirms the alignment of South Front Street.
