

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

Lots 10, 11, and 12 in Block J of Railroad Addition to the City of Ashland, in DLC No. 42, in the NE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian & Base, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To establish the easterly boundary of Lot 10, Block J, Railroad Addition, and to determine the distance from an existing structure to the boundary.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

Found monuments on the centerline of Fifth Street, between East Main Street and "B" Street as shown on Filed Survey No. 9638.

PROCEDURE:

Centerline monuments were located around the exterior of Block J, with the exception of the monument at the intersection of Fifth street and "C" Street. Mark Boyden had looked for a monument at this location without success during the course of Survey No. 9638. To establish the intersection, he had used proportionate measurements along Fifth Street between "B" Street and East Main Street. Everett Swain had apparently used similar methods to establish the centerline monument at the intersection of Sixth Street and "C" Street. Following their examples, I proportioned distances along Fifth Street to establish the intersection of Fifth and "C" Streets and to complete the exterior of Block J.

Individual Lot measurements were proportioned between the Block corners.
