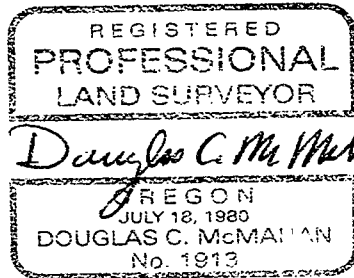


**AFFIDAVIT OF MONUMENTATION
FOR
DEFERRED MONUMENTS**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Douglas C. McMahan, a duly Registered Professional Land Surveyor of the State of Oregon, do hereby affirm that I have established with proper monuments as required by law those street center monuments shown as deferred on the Official Plat of SPRINGBROOK MEADOWS SUBDIVISION, as recorded in Volume 17, Page 34 of Plats in Jackson County, Oregon. The street center monuments along the centerline of Bell Court consist of a brass disk set in concrete stamped "LS 1913", the Point of Intersections (PI's) along Springbrook Road consist of 5/8" x 30" rebar with metal cap stamped "LS 1913".

This Affidavit is to comply with Chapter 92.070 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Oregon.

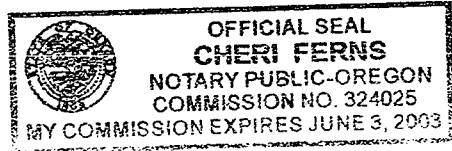
