## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH NO. 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Survey For: Vella Oregon Properties, L.L.C. 245 Front St. Central Point, Or. 97502

## Location:

Block 4 and 8 Oak Park Addition, City of Central Point, Oregon Southeast one-quarter of Section 3, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Or.

Basis of Bearing:

Filed Survey No. 1295, Centerline of Rail Road track.

Purpose:

To locate the boundary of the tract comprised of lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 of Block 4, lots 1, 2, 3, & 4 of Block 8, Cherry St. and Maple St. situated westerly of Front Street, the alley connecting said streets situated adjacent to the Central Oregon and Pacific Railroad right-of-way within the Oak Park Addition to the City of Central Point, Oregon described within Document Vol. 318 Pg. 350.

## Procedure:

Portions of the tract were surveyed and corner points established in 1959 by Surveyor Leland P. Lovejoy. In performing this survey, I utilized recovered monuments and procedures established by Surveyor Lovejoy in S.N. 1295.

I began this survey with a search for monuments established during filed survey No. 518, 1295, 2699, 3547, 5670, 10400 and 11305. I also searched for street intersection monuments for Maple and Cherry Streets to the east of Front Street. Previously established monuments situated at the intersection of Maple with First and Second Streets and along the westerly line of Front Street have been destroyed by street or utility construction and were not recovered.

I then performed a traverse survey tying the recovered monuments. From this data I computed the position for the corner points and established the monuments as shown on the attached Map of Survey.
