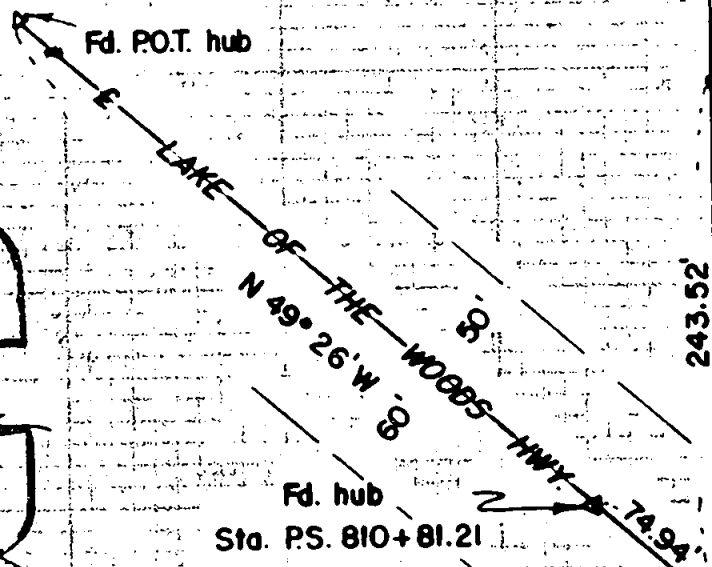

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Reg. D. Imperatrice  
Lake Creek, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument the location of the East boundary of Sec. 26, T36SR2E near the Lake-of-the-Woods Highway.

PROCEDURE: Set on the officially re-established 1/4 corner common to Sections 25 and 26, foresighted the officially re-established Southeast corner of said Section 26, and produced said line Southerly to intersect the State Highway centerline as shown.

Set iron pipe on line as shown.

A tie was made to a random hub set on Recorded Survey No. 1477 to determine a solar bearing for this Section line.
