Highway, Re: Filed County Survey No. 1212.

PURPOSE:

To monument that telecommunications easement described

in Instrument No 01-00764.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing E.D.M. equipment, traversed from the South-Southeast corner of DLC. #72, Easterly along the highway to the 1 1/2" iron pipe found at the Southwest corner of Clover Lane and the Jacksonville Highway, according to County Filed Survey No. 7165. Also tied in monuments along the Northerly right-of-way line of said highway as set on County Filed Survey Nos. 1212 and 15577. Also tied in the 5/8" iron pin 0.16 feet West of the Northwest corner of tract described in Volume 317, Page 149 as determined on County Filed Survey No. 13040.

The procedure in locating the Northerly right-of-way line of the Jacksonville Highway on County Filed Survey No. 1212 was considered the best available location and a line 60.00 feet Southerly at right angles from was utilized for the true Southerly right-of-way line of said highway. Offsets from those monumented set near said Southerly Highway line are as shown on the map to accompany this report.

A brief study of Recorded County Survey Nos. 649, 7165 and 13040 indicated that the side boundary lines of Deed Volume 317, Pages 149 and 151 were best determined on Recorded County Filed Survey No. 13040 and utilized on this survey.

It should be noted that an apparent gap of 1.44 feet occurs at the Northwest corner of County Filed Survey No. 7165 and the East line of Deed Volume 317, Page 151 as established on County Filed Survey NO. 13040.

Monumented the easement corners at positions shown, considering the description intent of "West along the highway boundary", thence South to mean a square 90° rectangle from said established Southerly right-of-way line of said highway.
