

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Lithia Real Estate, Inc. 360 East Jackson Street Medford, Oregon 97504

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument that tract of land described within Instrument No. 99-28292 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon, located in Lot 3 and a fraction of Lot 2, Block 2, Meekers Addition to the City of Medford, Oregon, along with Lots 35 & 36, Highland Addition to the City of Medford, lying situate within the southeast quarter of Section 24, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing a Nikon DTM 430 electronic total station and ranging prisms, I retrace Filed Survey No.'s 1659, 2216, 10287 & 15894, to establish boundary control for Highland Addition and Block 2 of Meekers Addition to the City of Medford. I find the recovered monuments measured by this survey matching nearly exactly with the record dimensions of Survey No. 15894, and hold them for position for street centerline control. Field measurements by this survey also fit relatively well with the other aforementioned surveys. The most easterly corner for Lot 3, Block 2, Meekers Addition, being the Point of Beginning for that tract of land described within said Instrument No. 99-28292, was determined by calculating a bearing-bearing intersection from a lead plug and tack monument recovered at the most southerly corner for said Lot 3 per Survey No. 10287, following the northwesterly line of Maple Street and intersecting with the southeasterly prolongation of the line between recovered bolts along the northeasterly line of said Lot 3 per Survey No. 2216. The boundary for said described tract was then calculated using the metes and bounds calls from said description. It should be noted that the northeasterly and southwesterly lines of said described tract were set out at the described calls of 100.0 feet within said Instrument No. 99-28292 and per Survey No. 10287, which would be 0.09 feet short of a split proportioned distance between the

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
