

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

N.E. 1/4 of section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Base and Meridian, City of Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument the rear property corners and sidelines of the land described by deed recorded as Document No. 00-26902 in Jackson County Official Records.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

True meridian at the N-S centerline of Section 9 as derived from the N.O.A.A. net established in 1968 and on file with the Jackson County Surveyor's office. The reference line for bearing control for this survey was taken from centerline monuments found at the intersection of 5th & "B" Street and 5th & "A" Street in the City of Ashland as N 15°46'27" E, being the centerline bearing of 5th Street as shown on that certain Map of Survey filed as Survey No. 8398 at the Jackson County Surveyor's office.

PROCEDURE:

The subject property is located in Block "D" of the "Map of the Railroad Addition to the Town of Ashland. Block "D" on said map is defined by "A" Street on the north with a record Right of Way width of 40', 5th Street on the east with a record Right of Way width of 70', "B" Street on the south with a record Right of Way width of 70', and 4th Street on the west with a record Right of Way width of 70'. Centerline monuments exist at all four street intersection locations. These monuments were accepted as monumenting street centerline intersections by Filed Survey No. 8398, Filed Survey No. 4937. Filed Survey No. 13702, and this survey.

Having established street center lines, Block "D" sidelines were established at record Right of Way widths. Holding record right of way widths (16') for all alleys, Block 'D' was further broken down and the subject property was established using proportionate measure. The rear property corners were monumented and monuments were set along the sidelines as well. The front property corners were not monumented since the existing building is currently undergoing renovations and any set monuments were likely to be destroyed.

The existing concrete building was found to be situated approximately I' over the easterly property line as shown on the map. The client has been informed of available options to reconcile this situation.
