

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Northeast 1/4 of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian and Base, City of Ashland, Jackson County Oregon

### PURPOSE:

To locate and monument the exterior boundary of the land described by deed recorded in Document Number 84-17908, Jackson County Official Records

# BASIS OF BEARINGS:

Found monuments on the centerline of Main Street in the City of Ashland at the southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 43 and at the intersection of the centerline of Main Street with the centerline of Morton Street as N 81°33'03" W per Filed Survey Number 8660

# PROCEDURE:

The subject property is described as Lot 1 and Lot 2 in Block "W" of the Railroad's Second Addition to the Town of Ashland. Block "W" is bounded on the north by "C" Street, on the East by the westerly line of DLC No. 43, on the South by East Main Street, and on the West by 8th Street. This survey proceeded to establish Block "W" and proportion lot lines within by locating these bounds from existing monuments.

The Map of the Railroad's Second Addition to the Town of Ashland states that the streets of the Railroad's Second Addition are a continuation of the streets of the Railroad Addition. Therefore, "C" Street was located by projecting the centerline of "C" Street from the Railroad Addition using centerline monuments at "C" & 7th Streets and "C" & 8th Streets. The westerly line of DLC 43 is fixed by monuments found at the SE corner of DLC 42 and at the SW corner of DLC 43. The centerline of East Main Street as determined by monuments shown of Filed Survey Number 5939 and Filed Survey Number 8660 was accepted as the centerline of East Main Street by this survey as well. Found monuments on East Main Street at 8th Street and Alida Street fall slightly off line and were not accepted as controlling the centerline of East Main. To do so would introduce angle points on East Main at each Block. This I believe is not the intent of the Official Map of Ashland adopted in 1888 which shows angle points in East main Street near Morton Street and at the SW corner of DLC 43. I believe that FS 5939 and FS 8660 were following this intent by using monuments to control the centerline of East Main Street that were at or nearest to the angle point locations as shown on the 1888 map. The centerline of 8th Street was located by centerline monuments on 8th Street at East Main Street(controlling 8th Street only) and "C" Street.

Plat record widths were given East Main, 8th, and "C" Streets and Lots were proportion in the resultant block from 8th Street to the DLC line. Property corners were monumented and exterior fences located. It should be noted that a wood picket/wood board fence encroaches by as much as 5.8 feet on the westerly boundary.
