PROCEDURE:
THE RECORD INDICATES THAT THE ONLY SURVEYOR TO HAVE BEEN IN THIS BLOCK SINCE 1910 WAS
L.E. AGER, A REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR IN THE STATE OF OREGON, DURING THE EXECUTION OF

RECORDS, JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON (ASSESSOR'S MAP NUMBER T39-IE-I5BB, TAX LOTS

August 10, 2001

A CONTROL TRAVERSE WAS RUN AROUND THE ORIGINAL BLOCK E' OF SAID SUBDIVISION, AS WELL AS, A TIE TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 15. AN EXTENSIVE AND DILIGENT SEARCH WAS MADE TO RECOVER THE ORIGINAL 1910 BLOCK AND LOT CORNERS AS PER THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF FAIRVIEW ADDITION. ENOUGH ORIGINAL MONUMENTS WERE RECOVERED TO DETERMINE THAT THE ORIGINAL SURVEYOR WAS USING I" INNER DIAMETER BLACK IRON PIPE TO MONUMENT THE BLOCK AND LOT CORNERS OF SAID SUBDIVISION. THE 1/2 DIAMETER IRON PIPE FOUND NEAR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT T, ALTHOUGH OF OLD ORIGIN IS NOT CONSISTENT WITH OTHER MONUMENTS SET IN 1910. IN THE EARLY 1960'S THE CITY OF ASHLAND MADE EXTENSIVE ROAD IMPROVEMENTS TO THE STREETS SURROUNDING THIS BLOCK, WHICH LEAD TO THE LOSS OF MANY OF THE ORIGINAL 1910 MONUMENTS.


NUMEROUS 3/4" INNER DIAMETER GALVANIZED IRON PIPES WERE DISCOVERED AT OR NEAR THE PLAT RECORD CORNER LOCATIONS. THE ORIGIN OF THESE PIPES IS UNKNOWN; AN INQUIRY MADE WITH CITY OF ASHLAND SURVEYOR, JIM OLSEN. WE RESEARCHED THE CITY'S RECORDS AND FOUND NO EVIDENCE AS TO THE ORIGIN OF THESE 3/4" DIAMETER IRON PIPES. HE STATED THAT HE SEEMED TO REMEMBER THE CITY DOING SOME WORK IN THAT AREA, BUT IT WAS PRIOR TO HIS TENURE. AND HE COULD NOT BE SPECIFIC. WE ALSO DISCUSSED THE PROBABILITY OF THESE MONUMENTS BEING SET BY EVERETT SWAIN, A FORMER REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR IN THE STATE OF OREGON NOW RETIRED AND OUT OF THE AREA. MR. SWAIN, A SURVEYOR OF HIGH STANDING, HAD PREFORMED NUMEROUS CONTROL SURVEYS IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND WHILE IN PRACTICE. THE 3/4" DIAMETER PIPES APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN SET SOME TIME JUST PRIOR TO THE DEVELOPMENT AND STREET IMPROVEMENTS IN THIS AREA DURING THE EARLY 1960'S; EVIDENCED BY THEIR DEPTH AND EXISTING LANDSCAPING.

THE 3/4" DIAMETER IRON PIPE FOUND NEAR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 26 WAS HELD AND ACCEPTED AS BEING THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF BLOCK "E" OF SAID SUBDIVISION; THE LOCATION OF THIS IRON PIPE FOUND NEAR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 8 WAS HELD TO DETERMINE THE EASTERLY LINE OF BLOCK "E". NOTE: THE BEARING FROM THE PIPE FOUND NEAR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 25, S. 0°09'26" E. IT IS EVIDENT THAT SOMEONE WITH GREAT SURVEYING SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE PLACED THESE MONUMENTS OF UNKNOWN ORIGIN.

BLOCK 'E' OF FAIRVIEW ADDITION WAS THEN PROPORTION AGAINST THE PLAT RECORD, UTILIZING THE FOUND 3/4" DIAMETER IRON PIPES AND THE FOUND ORIGINAL ISIO MONUMENTS AS SHOWN; THE ORIGINAL ISIO MONUMENT FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT IS WAS HELD TO CONTROL THE LENGTH OF BLOCK 'E' TO THE SOUTH MAKING USE OF THE FOUND 3/4" IRON PIPES PRODUCED STREET ALIGNMENTS THAT WERE PARALLEL AND PERPENDICULAR AS PORTRAYED ON THE ORIGINAL PLAT.

THE DEED BOUNDARIES OF DOCUMENT NUMBER 95-06472, OFFICIAL RECORDS, JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON, WERE THEN COMPUTED AND MONUMENTED AS SHOWN. MONUMENTS SET ON THIS SURVEY CONSIST OF 5/8" X 30" STEEL PINS WITH RED PLASTIC CAPS
