I, Robert V. Neathamer, a Registered Professional Land Surveyor of the State of Oregon, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with the proper monuments as provided by law, the tract of land shown hereon and that this plat is a correct representation of said tract and that the following is an accurate description of the boundary:

All that real property situated in the Southwest One-quarter of Section 13 and the Southeast One-quarter of Section 14, Township 39 South, Range l'East of the Willamette Meridian, within the City on Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a brass disk set in concrete, marking the Initial Point of Oak Knoll Meadows Subdivision, Phase 3, recorded August 15, 1990 in Volume 16 of Plats at Page 71 of the Records of Jackson County, Oregón, being on the westerly boundary of said Phase 3 and on the easterly right-of-way of Interstate 5; thence along said Phase 3 boundary and said rightof-way the following courses and distances: South 37°56'28" East, a distance of 51.53 feet to a 5/8-inch diaméter iron pin with a yellow plastic cap marked "D. MCMAHAN LS 1913"; thence South 20°55'14" East, a distance of 201.00 feet to a 5/8-inch diameter iron pin with a yellow plastic cap marked "D. MCMAHAN LS 1913"; thence South 26°37'52" East, a distance of 173.01 feet to a found 5/8-inch diameter iron pin with a yellow plastic cap marked "D. MCMAHAN LS 1913", and the True Point of Beginning; thence leaving said right-of-way and continuing along the boundary of said Phase 3, the following courses and distances: North 63°22'08" East, a distance of 90.26 feet to a set 5/8-inch diameter iron pin with a yellow plastic cap marked "NEATHAMER LS 2675"; thence South 77°26'18" East, a distance of 15.78 feet to a set 5/8-inch diameter iron pin with a yellow plastic cap marked "NEATHAMER LS 2675"; thence North 35°17'52" East, a distance of 82.24 feet to a found 5/8-inch diameter iron pin marked "D. SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Perform a boundary survey and prepare a Final Plat pursuant to Client's instructions and Planning Action Number 2000-085 as administratively approved by the City of Ashland Planning Department on July 19, 2000.

Procedure:

Utilizing a Nikon DTM-520 and a Husky FS-2 with TDS software, all found monuments were tied in a closed traverse.

Based on said traverse, Surveys Numbered 12147 and 14993 on file in the Jackson County Survéyor's Office, and Document Number 90-02617, Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon, the project boundaries and interior lots were computed and monumented as depicted hereon.
