



SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

Lots 18 and 19 of Hunsaker's Addition to the City of Ashland, in the Southeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian & Base, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument a Partition of the client's property as requested under Planning Action No. PA 2001-010.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

True meridian at north-south centerline of Section 9 as derived from the N.O.A.A. net established in 1968 and on file in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor. The reference line for bearing control for this survey was taken from monuments found along the centerline of Iowa Street between Harrison and Morton Streets as shown on Filed Surveys No. 16519 and 10479. This bearing was rotated 0° 01' 04" clockwise from true meridian.

PROCEDURE:

Hunsaker's Addition to the City of Ashland was platted in 1888. I have found no evidence of monuments being set for the original subdivision or of any subsequent surveys being done within this block. A check of the outer boundary description of the subdivision revealed an error of closure of 11 feet and the block containing Lots 18 and 19, in which the northeasterly and southwesterly lines should be of equal length, had a difference of one foot in record lengths. After surveying the block, I found that the measured length was nearly 6 feet longer than the record length. McCall's 1888 map of the City of Ashland does not show a direct distance along Siskiyou Boulevard between Sherman Street and Morton Street, but a calculated distance was within one foot of the distance I measured. This would indicate that the streets, as currently monumented, are not far from where they were at the time of the subdivision so there must have been a measurement or calculation error within this block. With no original monuments or notes which would indicate otherwise, I proportioned the additional distance throughout the block along the Siskiyou Boulevard right of way.


Typically the additional distance along the northeasterly line of the alley would also be distributed in proportion to each Lot's width. However in this case, with the one foot difference between this line and the Siskiyou Boulevard right of way, I could not determine with any degree of certainty how to proportion the error. The original plat shows the Lot lines perpendicular to the alley and the boulevard, so I held this relationship. I also held the record distance of 142 feet from the Boulevard to the alley as was done on Surveys No. 10479 and 16519.

Be it hereby noted that on the Land Partition Survey for Ken Baker recorded September 18, 2001 as Partition Plat No. P-53-2001 of the records of Partition Plats in Jackson County, Oregon, Index Volume 12, Page 53, an error was made in calculating the length of the block between Sherman Street and Morton Street. The centerline of Sherman Street, as monumented, is not the line between Hunsaker's Addition and Pracht's Addition as is implied on Survey No. 4530 and McCall's 1888 Map of the City of Ashland, but is 5.00 feet easterly of said line; at the center of the 50' wide right of way. This can be verified by comparing the distance on the plat of Pracht's Addition between the centerlines of Union Street (across Lots 15, 30,53, and 69) and Sherman Street with the distance between the two monuments set by McCall to mark the intersections of these two streets with Siskiyou Boulevard as shown on said 1888 Map. In the narratives which accompany Filed Surveys No. 4515 and 4530, surveyor Everett Swain describes setting the replacement monument at Siskiyou Boulevard and Sherman Street at the calculated position of the original stone as shown on said 1888 Map.

On Sheet 2 of said partition plat, the proportioned distances along the Siskiyou Boulevard right of way and along the alley which parallels Siskiyou Boulevard have been adjusted to reflect the correct block width. The tie from the most westerly corner of the Partition to the Southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 39 has also been corrected. The area of Parcel 1 and Parcel 2 have been adjusted accordingly. Also on said Sheet 2, Lot 13 of Hunsaker's Addition was labeled as being described in Volume 226, Page 605, Deed Records, Jackson County, Oregon. The correct document number is Volume 266, Page 605. These changes to Sheet 2 are further clarified and highlighted in bold type on "Exhibit A" and "Exhibit B" attached hereto and made a part hereof. The monuments set for the northwest and southwest corners of Parcel 1 and the northeast corner of Parcel 2 have been re-set at their correct locations. The southeast corner of Parcel 2 could not be re-set. The lead plug with tack and tag that was set in 2001 is now a witness corner.
