

Surveyor's Certificate

I, Haroid L. Center, duly registered Professional Land Surveyor of the State of Oregon, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with the proper monuments as provided by law, the tract of land hereon shown, this said plat being a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines.

Commencing at the southwest corner of Parcel No. 2, of the Partition Plat recorded in Volume 1, Page 36 of the "Minor Partitions" of Jackson County, Oregon, said corner point being common with the easterly right-of-way for Oak Street and situated on the Boundary Line by Agreement recorded as Document No. 76-02704 Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon; from which a City of Ashland brass cap centerline street monument bears S.17°48'57"W., 100.76 feet; thence along said agreement line N.89°58'17"E., 5.00 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter iron pin marking the INITIAL POINT OF BEGINNING; thence S.89*58'17"W., 5.00 feet; thence N.00°25'17"E. (record N.00°27'00"E.) parallel with Oak Street, 101.63 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter iron pin, thence N.89°58'17"E. PURPOSE: To survey and monument a Land Partition of Parcels 1 and 2 of the Minor Land Partition filed as Survey No. 6300, and Recored in Volume 1, Page 36 of the "Minor Land Partitions" of Jackson County, Oregon.
