

NOTES

Parcels I and 2 of the Partition Plat depicted hereon are subject to the following record matters:

- (1) The effect on said parcels, or any part thereof, lying within the Medford Irrigation District, and subject to all water and irrigation rights, easements for ditches and canals, and all regulations of said District, including any and all assessments, liens and charges assessed, and to be assessed.
- (2) Deferred Improvement Agreement with the City of Medford, subject to the terms and provisions thereof, recorded February II, 1986, Document Number 86-02433, Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon.
- (3) A perpetual public utilities easement, 10.00 feet in width, as dedicated by Instrument recorded October 19, 1994 as Number 93-39186, of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon.
- (4) A perpetual easement for facilities of public utilities, as dedicated by Instrument recorded October 19, 1994 as Number 94-37483, of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon.
- (5) A perpetual non-exclusive easement for ingress and egress over a paved driveway, and for electrical power and lighting, subject to terms and provisions thereof, as granted by Instrument recorded March 1, 1995, Document Number 95-05565, Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon. Affects Parcel I as depicted hereon.
- (6) The terms and provisions contained in Deed recorded March 1, 1995 as Document Number 95-05566, Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon.
- (7) Easements for existing gas main, sanitary sewer, and storm sewer drain, as set forth in Instrument recorded June 13, 1996 as Document Number 96-19740, Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon.
- (8) Limitations and restrictions on sale and use set out in Chapter 97, Oregon Revised Statutes. Affects Parcel I as depicted hereon.
- (9) Those portions sold for cemetery plots or used for interred remains, and rights of owners thereof. Affects Parcel I as depicted hereon.
- (10) Rights in dedicated Avenues, Streets, Alleys, Walks, Driveways and Parks. Affects Parcel I as depicted hereon.
- (11) Any violation, or non-compliance with, the provisions of Chapter 97, Oregon Revised Statutes, imposing limitation on the use of said property for cemetery purposes or any municipal regulations pertaining thereto. Affects Parcel I as depicted hereon.

NARRATIVE:

To perform a survey for Leavitt Oregon, Inc. and monument the property pursuant to the conditionally approved Tentative Partition Plat, File Number LPD-01-149, by the City of Medford Planning Commission on October 31, 2001.

Procedure: Utilizing a Nikon DTM-520 Total Station, and a Ranger 200R Data Collector with TDS software, all found monuments, as depicted hereon, were tied in a closed loop traverse.

> Based on said traverse, Survey Number 15049, 10568, 10413, and 16823, on file in the Jackson County Surveyor's Office, Document Number 00-44048 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon, and the conditionally approved Tentative Partition Plat, the resultant the boundaries of Parcel I and Parcel 2 were computed and monumented as depicted hereon.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Robert V. Neathamer, a Registered Professional Land Surveyor of the State of Oregon, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with the proper monuments as provided by law, the tract of land shown hereon and that this plat is a correct representation of said tract and that the following is an accurate description of the boundary:

Blocks One (1) to Twenty (20) inclusive, of SISKIYOU MEMORIAL PARK in the City of Medford, Jackson County, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof, now of record, located in the Southwest and Southeast One-quarters of Section 29, Township 37 South, Range | West of the Willamette Meridian in the City of Medford, Jackson County, Oregon, moré particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Donation Land Claim Number 50 in said township, range and meridian; thence West, a distance of 30.02 feet; thence North, a distance of 29.81 feet to a 5/8-inch rebar with yellow plastic cap marked: "NEATHAMER LS 2675", on the northerly right-of-way of Greenwood Street and the Initial Point of Beginning; thence South 89°54'07" West, along said northerly right-of-way, a distance of 1,081.58 feet to a found monument with an aluminum cap marked: "BOYDEN PLS 281" and the beginning of a curve to the right having a radius of 10.00 feet and a central angle of 3°52′15″; thence along the arc of said curve a distance of 0.53 feet, the long chord of said curve bears North 88°34'39" West, a distance of 0.53 feet to the easterly right-of way of Highland Drive; thence North 00°17′35″ East, along said easterly right-of-way, a distance of 916.45 feet to a found monument with a yellow plastic cap marked: "KAISER PLS 803" on the southerly right-of-way of Siskiyou Boulevard; thence along said southerly right-of way the following courses and distances: North 75°27'55" East, a distance of 129.00 feet to a found monument with a yellow plastic cap marked: "KAISER PLS 803"; North 82°21'08" East, a distance of 56.79 feet to the beginning of a curve to the left having a radius of 1,836.26 feet and a central angle of 5°28'02"; thence along the arc of said curve a distance of 175.22 feet, the long chord of said curve bears North 86°57'50" East, a distance of 175.15 feet to a found monument with a yellow plastic cap marked: "KAISER PLS 803"; North 84°14'39" East, a distance of 440.44 feet to a found monument with an aluminum cap marked: "BOYDEN PLS 281" and the beginning of a curve to the right having a radius of 1,357.93 feet and a central angle of 20°25'07", thence along the arc of said curve a distance of 483.93 feet, the long chord of said curve bears South 85°34'31" East, a distance of 481.37 feet to a found monument with an aluminum cap marked: "BOYDEN PLS 281"; South 75°22'51" East, a distance of 221.40 feet to a found monument with an aluminum cap marked: "BOYDEN PLS 281" to the beginning of a curve to the right having a radius of 10.00 feet and a central angle of 86°03'02"; thence along the arc of said curve a distance of 15.02 feet, the long chord of said curve bears South 32°21'20" East, a distance of 13.65 feet to a found monument with an aluminum cap marked: "BOYDEN PLS 281", on the westerly right-of-way of Windsor Avenue; thence South 10°40'11" West, along said westerly right-of-way, a distance of 275.32 feet to a found 3/4-inch diameter smooth iron pin at the beginning of a curve to the left having a radius of 177.79 feet and a central angle of 68°08'24"; thence along the arc of said curve a distance of 211.44 feet, the long chord of said curve bears South 23°24'01" East, a distance of 199.20 feet; thence along the southerly right-of-way of Windsor Avenue, South 57°28'13" East, a distance of 95.76 feet to a found 3/4-inch diameter smooth iron pin and the beginning of curve to the left having a radius of 460.58 feet and a central angle of 12°05'50"; thence along the arc of said curve a distance of 97.24 feet, the long chord of said curve bears South 63°31'08" East, a distance of 97.06 feet to a found I inch diameter smooth iron pin; thence South 00°00'35" East, a distance of 352.24 feet to a found 5/8-inch diameter iron pin; thence South 89°41'55" West, a distance 554.13 feet to a found 5/8-inch diameter iron pin; thence South 89°46'15" West, a distance of 60.00 feet to the Initial Point of Beginning.
