



**SURVEY NARRATIVE**

**PURPOSE:**  
To monument a property line adjustment as required by Jackson County Planning per file number 2000-54-PLA and 2000-45-PLA

**PROCEDURE:**  
Tied monuments set and found on filed surveys 9566 and 6290 to establish the right of way line of Ross Lane. I tied the Donation Land Claim corners along Rossanley Drive to establish the right of way of Rossanley Drive. Monuments were set along the Westerly top of bank of Griffin Creek to reference Deed calls to the angle points along the newly adjusted Easterly line. The Southerly line of the Easterly 99.00 feet of Volume 404, Page 93 of the Deed Records of Jackson County was monumented by holding the found monument set on filed survey number 675 and running parallel with the centerline of Ross Lane.
