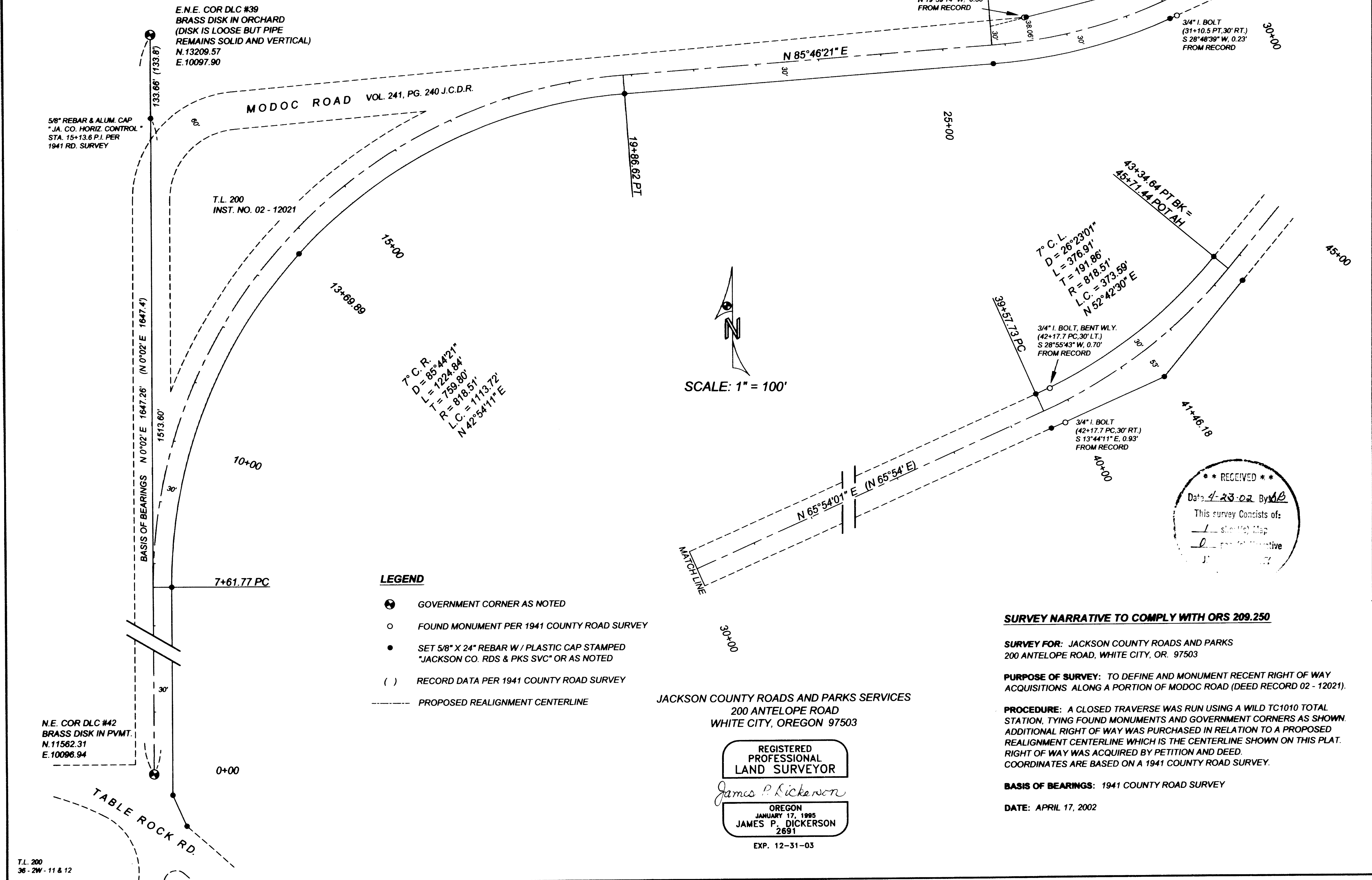


**MODOC ROAD RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITIONS**

**SURVEY FOR:** JACKSON COUNTY ROADS AND PARKS  
200 ANTELOPE ROAD, WHITE CITY, OR. 97503

**PURPOSE OF SURVEY:** TO DEFINE AND MONUMENT RECENT RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITIONS ALONG A PORTION OF MODOC ROAD (DEED RECORD 02 - 12021).

**PROCEDURE:** A CLOSED TRAVERSE WAS RUN USING A WILD TC1010 TOTAL STATION. TYING FOUND MONUMENTS AND GOVERNMENT CORNERS AS SHOWN. ADDITIONAL RIGHT OF WAY WAS PURCHASED IN RELATION TO A PROPOSED REALIGNMENT CENTERLINE WHICH IS THE CENTERLINE SHOWN ON THIS PLAT. RIGHT OF WAY WAS ACQUIRED BY PETITION AND DEED. COORDINATES ARE BASED ON A 1941 COUNTY ROAD SURVEY.
