

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

The Northwest Quarter of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, City of Talent, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument a portion of the Talent Elementary School site.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

The line between the Northwest Corner of Donation Land Claim No. 64 and the Initial Point of the Hi-Land Addition to Talent as shown on Filed Survey No. 3105.

PROCEDURE:

The Talent Elementary School property is described as two parcels. The northerly parcel, as described in Volume 90, Page 175, lies between the centerline of Wagner Creek Road on the West and the easterly line of Second Street on the east. The northerly line is the centerline of Wagner Street (formerly a part of Wagner Creek Road). County Road records for Wagner Creek Road (Vol. 1, Page 234) show a 40 foot wide right of way, being 20 feet on each side of centerline. Surveys No. 3105 and 12960 indicate a 60 foot wide right of way in this area but I was unable to find an additional dedication along this portion of the school frontage. Although the Road Records indicate that the centerline should follow the DLC line in this area, surveyors have used an "engineer's centerline" as defined by Survey No. 8527, between the Initial Point of the Hi-Land Addition and the intersection with Rapp Road. See Surveys No. 8527, 10109, and 11287.

For the centerline of Wagner Street, the record distance south from the Northwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 64 was held for it's intersection with Wagner Creek Road. The 5/8" iron pin at the angle point in Wagner Street has been accepted by prior surveys as the best evidence of the centerline and was used as such for this survey (see narrative, Survey No. 10656). I have set a monument at the intersection of the southerly Wagner Street right of way with the easterly line of a proposed 30' wide right of way for Wagner Creek Road. A description has been written for this 30' wide strip along the westerly side of Volume 90, Page 175, and the School District is currently in the process of granting this to the City of Talent.

The portion of Second Street which adjoins the northerly parcel was reserved as a road easement in Volume 90, Page 175, Deed Records. This road easement, together with the portion which runs east-west across the school property, was never accepted by the County and was recently relinquished by the heirs of the original grantors. Since there does not appear to be an easement or right of way for this portion of Second Street by deed or dedication, I have shown the west line of the street along the existing chain link fence, as a right of way by prescriptive use.

The southerly parcel was surveyed in 1965 and filed as Survey No. 3105. The current legal description was written to match that survey.
