SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250

OREGON REVISED STATUTES

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument the north boundary line of client's property, as described in Instrument No. 91-20710, Official Records, Jackson County, Oregon

PROCEDURE: The north boundary of the property being surveyed is located on the east—west center line of Section 18. The west 1/4 corner of Section 18 was reestablished by the Jackson County Surveyor in 1980. In 1997 the Bureau of Land Manangement surveyed Section 18 and they placed a bronze cap monument at the Center 1/4 corner. The B.L.M. survey has not, as of this date, not been filed as public record. Client and adjoining neighbor were advised that there is a possibility that the B.L.M. corner is subject to possible change, pending the final acceptance of the B.L.M. survey. Due to the cost that would be required to verify the B.L.M. monument, client was willing to accept the possibility of a change in location of his north boundary.

> Utilizing a Leica TC 1600 total station, a control traverse was run tying found monuments, as shown. The location of client's property corners was computed and monuments were set as shown.

MAP OF SURVEY FOR GLEN KUHL 9744 Ramsey Road Gold Hill, Or. 97525




