

REPORT ON COLLATERAL EVIDENCE FOUND NEAR THE NORTH
QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 5, T32SR2E.

Found stone in a mound of stone. No evidence could be found of the original witness trees.

From said stone,

A 7" Cedar with old blaze and "Yocom" printed on the blaze bears North 8° East, 6.0 feet to the center of the tree.

An 8" Fir with many cruiser's marks and a tag set by the Blister Rust Control by L. Ash bears South 79° East, 6.5 feet to the center of the tree.

By rough chaining, the South $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 32, T31SR2E bears Westerly 330 feet.
