**PURPOSE:** 

1. To determine the boundaries of the Guches property in


Sections 16 & 21, said Township and Range.

2. To locate and describe a 30-foot wide access and utility easement to supersede the "Easterly Branch" easement described in Instrument No. 94-15262, Official Records.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing E.D.M. equipment, ran random traverse closures around the 50+ acre tract in Section 16 and the 10+ acre tract in Section 21. Control for the Section 16 portion was determined from monuments set on Filed Survey No. 8208, No. 9270 and the B.L.M. survey of 1987. Control for the Section 21 portion was from the dependent resurvey by the B.L.M. in 1987. It should be noted that the traverse was not continued to the B.L.M. monument at the Northwest 1/16 section corner. B.L.M. line blazes, however, agreed with the "North-South" portion of the witness corner set near the Southwest corner of the 10+ acre tract in Section 21 by approximately 0.2 feet.


While traversing on Feb. 8, 2003, we found the ¼ corner monument firmly set with proper brass cap marking the ¼ corner to Sections 16 & 21. We tied in said monument, the original NE witness tree and Jackson County Surveyor NE and SW re-establishment bearing trees. Said monument did not agree with bearing trees reported by the B.L.M. in 1987 or the Jackson County Surveyor.

This discrepancy was reported to the County Surveyor, who re-set said monument in the proper position, North 3° 10' East, 17.9 feet as shown on this survey. This new corner position has been utilized for this survey.
