PER S/N 9151 12540 AND CITY OF ASHLAND REFERENCES (RECOVERED) EAST OR THE WEST HALF OF THESE LOTS. THIS FACT BECOMES RELEVANT THOUGH FOR THE REASONS FOLLOWING; IN 1978, SURVEYOR EVERETT SWAIN 1 1/2" ALUMINUM CAP ON 5/8" IRON PIN MARKED "LS 1071" PER S/N 7025 (RECOVERED) DID A RETRACEMENT OF THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARY OF WOOLEN'S ADDITION (SURVEY NO. 7545), APPARANTLY BECAUSE OF A LACK OF ORIGINAL 5/8" IRON PIN W/ YELLOW PLASTIC CAP MARKED "D.W. EDWARDS MONUMENTATION COULD BE FOUND OF THE BLOCK OR LOT CORNERS. THE PLS 741" PER S/N 12387 (RECOVERED) LINES RUNNING EAST-WEST WERE FOUND TO BE CONSIDERABLY SHORTER THAN 5/8" COPPER PLUG IN CONCRETE PER S/N 9293 (RECOVERED) THE WOOLEN PLAT RECORD WHEN MEASURED, AND THE INTERIOR BLOCKS WERE 5/8"x 24" IRON PIN W/ ORANGE PLASTIC CAP MARKED THEN LAID OUT BY PROPORTIONAL METHODS BY THIS SURVEY. DESCRIBED MONUMENTS FOUND ON THE GROUND. WHEN CENTER MEASURES 198.05' [200'] TO THE REFERENCE INTERSECTION POINTS FROM MONUMENTS HE RECOVERS AT OFFICIAL RECORDS, JACKSON COUNTY RECORDER O.R. THE CENTERLINE INTERSECTIONS OF SCENIC DRIVE WITH WIMER & WEST DEED RECORD VOLUME/PAGE, JACKSON COUNTY RECORDER D.R.STREETS, HE FINDS THE DISTANCE BETWEEN SCENIC AND ALTA TO BE 240 Ü SURVEY RECORD S/N 12387 & 12540 FEET, WHICH MATCHES THE WOOLEN PLAT RECORD, AND HOLDS IT FOR POSITION. THEN IN 1981, SURVEYOR VERLYN THOMAS RETRACES THE SAME SURVEY RECORD S/N 7025 (())EXTERIOR BOUNDARY OF WOOLEN'S ADDITION (SURVEY NO. 9151) AND COMES DEED RECORD PER 89/104 & 92/175 Z TO THE SAME RESOLUTION AS SWAIN AS TO THE DEFICIANCY IN THE MEASURED PLAT RECORD OF WOOLEN'S ADDITION TO CITY OF ASHLAND EAST-WEST LINES AND ALSO USES PROPORTIONAL METHODS TO LAY OUT THE E INTERIOR BLOCKS. THEREFORE, I HOLD THE EAST 100 FEET OF LOTS 5 & 6 FOR THE WIDTH OF THE OFFICE OF THE JACKSON COUNTY SURVEYOR. THE WERBLOW PARCEL AS CALLED OUT IN SAID VOLUME 89, PAGE 104 WHICH IS THE SENIOR DEED. LEAVING A REMAINING WIDTH OF 98 FEET FOR THE HOLSTEIN PARCEL WEST OF WERBLOW.
