

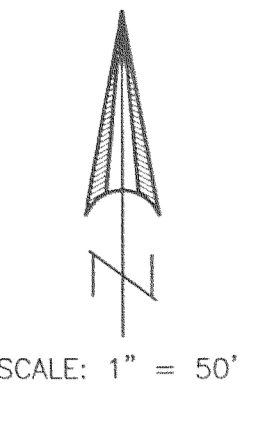

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: Boundary survey of tract described in Vol. 191, Page 519 D.R.

PROCEDURE: Information on survey by C.Z. Boyden for the U.S. Bureau of Fisheries dated May, 1931 (a copy of which was gratuitously supplied by M.E. Boyden) along with deed recorded in Volume 191, Page 519 D.R. was used to locate the boundaries of the subject property. A copy of this 1931 survey has been attached as Exhibit "A".

There are 3 points on the property boundary described in Vol. 191, page 519 that are called for as being "a point in Butte Creek". There is nowhere in this deed calling for "running along the creek" or in any way indicating that any of the lines described are to run along the creek. There is also no call as to where in the creek these points are, the center, the edge or someplace inbetween. In examining the 1931 survey map, I see nothing that would indicate to me that any of the lines are intended to run along the center of the creek, although, some of the lines do run in and out of the creek. It appears as though 3 of the corners happen to fall in the creek. The boundaries were located from monuments found set on the 1931 survey and at proportionate positions where the original monuments could not be located.

NOTE: Deeds North of the Section line call to the Section line. Vol. 191, Page 519 D.R. does not call to the Section line. Our survey is a retracement of property described in Vol. 191, Page 519 D.R. as shown on the 1931 survey by C.Z. Boyden.

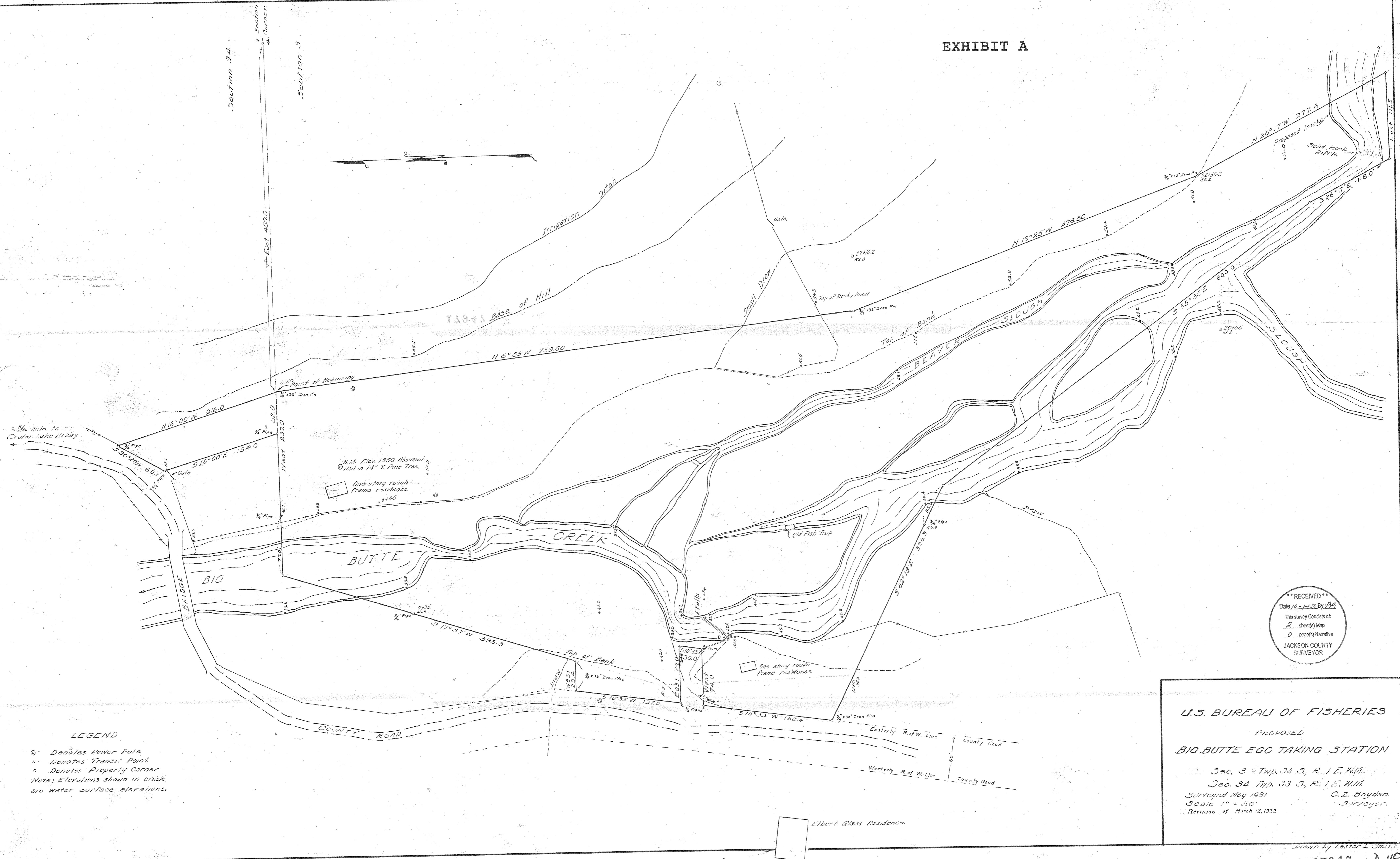
