

AFFIDAVIT OF MONUMENTATION
FOR
DEFERRED MONUMENTS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Douglas C. McMahan, a duly Registered Professional Land Surveyor of the State of Oregon, do hereby affirm that I have established with proper monuments as required by law those monuments shown as deferred on the Official Plat of JACKSON CREEK ESTATES SUBDIVISION, UNIT NO. 7, as recorded in Volume 21, Page 29 of Plats in Jackson County, Oregon. The deferred street center monuments consist of a brass disc set flush in concrete stamped "LS 1913." The deferred lot corners are 5/8 inch x 24 inch rebar with yellow plastic caps marked "D.MCMAHAN LS 1913."

EXCEPT:

Lead plugs with tack and brass washer stamped "LS 1913" were set for monument at the Northeast corner of Lot 240, at the point of curve on the Jackson Creek Drive side of Lot 226, a 1.00 foot witness to South of the point of tangent on the Beall Lane side of Lot 226, and a 1.00 foot witness to East of point of curve on the Jackson Creek side of Lot 227.

This Affidavit is to comply with Chapter 92.070 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Oregon.
