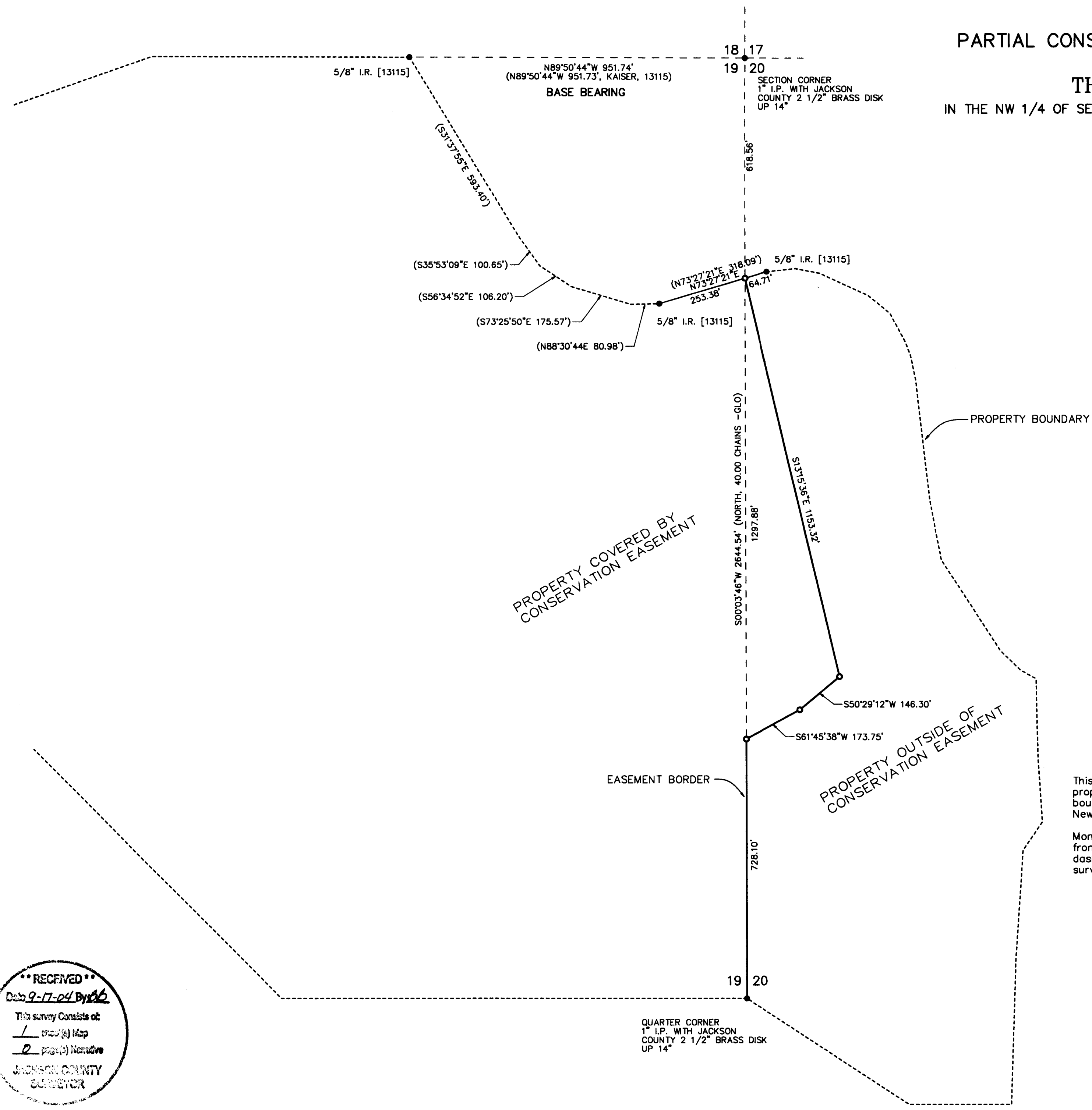


PARTIAL CONSERVATION EASEMENT BOUNDARY SURVEY

Monuments found as noted were used for control. The basis of bearings is from Filed Survey No. 13115. The property boundaries depicted by short-dashed lines were not surveyed; their locations were determined by deeds and surveys of record.
