SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Survey For: Michelle and Dana Peterson 5950 Abbie Lane Gold Hill, OR. 96525

Location:

Northeast One-Quarter Section 10, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose:

To survey and establish monuments marking the corners of the land described within Instrument No. 2003-16959.


Procedure:

I began this survey with a review of the prior surveys performed within the area and the deeds controlling the location of the subject property. BLM had performed a dependant resurvey of the line between Sections 10 and 11, re-establishing the corner to Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11 and establishing the north one-sixteenth corner to sections 10 and 11 in 1961. Surveyor D. W. Edwards, LS 741 had performed dependent resurveys (reference SN 10488 and 10546) within Section 10 establishing corners to control the parent tract and adjacent property corners. Lloyd R. Smith, LS 2011 had performed a survey (reference SN 18237) to re-establish monuments established by surveyor Edwards.

The parent tract was originally owned by G. B. Reames; et-al reference Volume 439, Page 487 with the parent property being described by aliquot part of section. Reames; et-al subsequently divided the property into smaller areas. Descriptions contained calls to metal stakes, fences and references to cardinal (referred to as true within the descriptions) bearings with distances in chains.

I began my field survey by utilizing a hand held GPS devise and determined UTM coordinates at the section corner, north one-sixteenth corner, and at corner points established by Surveyor Edwards, from this data I computed a search area for the corner points of the subject and adjacent property where calls to specific features were contained within the deeds. I then located each area using the GPS devise and performed an extensive search for evidence called for in the respective deeds. Near the northeast corner of my clients property, I recovered a section of metal fence post which had been driven solidly into the ground, extending 0.8 feet above the surface with a full length fence post driven adjacent with a metal "no trespassing " sign attached. I consulted the landowner to the east and he informed me that he had installed the metal stake/posts to mark the corner of his property, control access into a "shooting range" and control livestock. He indicated he had not recovered any metal stakes at or near his corner points.

I performed a diligent search at each area utilizing a magnetic pin finder to search for evidence of metal stakes and the remains of old fence wire without success. Surveyor Edwards or Smith make no reference to locating such items referenced within the deeds.





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A review of Surveyor Edwards procedure (reference SN 10546) indicates he utilized the sectional subdivision lines and proportional and deed record measurement to control the established corner monuments. This approach is the best alternative where the deed descriptions are consistent with each other and the control features called within the deed could not be identified. The apparent intent was to divide the property with common boundary lines. Monuments established by Surveyor Edwards have been utilized for development of access routes and location of improvements within the area and have been accepted for a considerable period of time. I established the monuments as shown on the attached map of survey utilizing the same methods accepting the location of the found monuments.
