


2. To monument the relocated C.S. 1/16 corner, Section 32, after the change in the Central-Quarter corner of

Section 32 by County Filed Survey No. 13193.

PROCEDURE: By E.D.M. traverse, ran from the South ¼ corner of Section 32, Northerly and Easterly, along lines shown on the accompanying map,, to the SE 1/16 corner of Section 32 as monumented on said Filed Survey No. 7772. A slight difference in distance with same Survey No. 7772 is as shown. This survey is a continuation of Filed Survey No. 7772 by Gary Kaiser, from 1976 to 1979, wherein I am in possession of the field notes, computations, and records search of said survey. A later recorded Survey No. 13193, by Martin C. Stewart (PLS 2057), relocated the center ¼ corner of Section 32,, South 89° 35' East, 3.18 feet from Gary Kaiser's monument. Stewart and I both agreed from searching Kaiser's computations, that the Kaiser monuments was set 3.0 feet too far West of the intended position.

Using Kaiser's coordinates, we recomputed the Stewart position for the true center Quarter corner and then monumented the C.S. 1/6 corner as shown. This previous Kaiser survey (under my assistance) did deed record research to determine the ownership of the North 396.00 feet of the SW ½ of the SE ½ of said Section 32.
