

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO RESOLVE THE EXISTING FIELD LOCATIONS FOR THE EXISTING RIGHT OF WAY CENTERLINE ALIGNMENTS AND ROAD WIDTHS FOR A PORTION OF DEAD INDIAN MEMORIAL ROAD IN JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON. THE SURVEY WAS MADE AT THE REQUEST OF JACKSON COUNTY ROADS, PARKS AND PLANNING SERVICES WHICH HAS PLANS TO REPLACE THE EXISTING BEAR CREEK BRIDGE (NO. 37) OVER BEAR CREEK. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO PERPETUATE THE EXISTING LOCATIONS OF SURVEY MONUMENTS OF RECORD THAT MAY BECOME DESTROYED BY FUTURE CONSTRUCTION IMPROVEMENTS. PERPETUATION OF THE MONUMENT LOCATIONS WAS ACCOMPLISHED BY TYING THE MONUMENTS TO THE PROJECT CONTROL NETWORK. THIS SURVEY MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A RECOVERY SURVEY AS OUTLINED IN THE OREGON REVISED STATUTES CHAPTER 209.155.

IN PERFORMING THE INITIAL STATIC GPS SURVEY TO ESTABLISH PROJECT CONTROL IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THE RECORD POSITION OF NGS HARN STATION DESIGNATION NZ0978 (OBEC 20) DID NOT FIT WELL WITH THE PUBLISHED NAD 83(98) VALUES. AFTER REVIEWING POINT DOCUMENTATION, IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THIS POINT WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE APRIL 2000 NGS ADJUSTMENT. THE POSITION WAS THEN ADJUSTED HOLDING NGS HARNS STATIONS NZ1326 (OBEC 10) AND A12003 (OBEC 30), THEN HELD TO CONTROL SUBSEQUENTLY TIED POINTS SHOWN ON THIS SURVEY.

THIS SURVEY UTILIZED A LOCAL DATUM PLANE (LDP) COORDINATE SYSTEM, WHICH IS RELATIVE TO THE OREGON STATE PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM, SOUTH ZONE - NAD83 (98). TO CONVERT THE LDP COORDINATES TO OREGON STATE PLANE SOUTH ZONE NAD83 (98), MULTIPLY THE COORDINATES BY A COMBINED SCALE FACTOR OF 0.999948888. OBEC POINT NUMBERS 70 AND 630 WERE CHOSEN FOR THE PROJECT BASIS OF BEARING TO REFLECT LOCAL SITE VALUES WITHIN THE PROJECT LDP.

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED IN INTERNATIONAL FEET. TO CONVERT FROM INTERNATIONAL FEET TO METERS MULTIPLY BY .3048. TO CONVERT FROM INTERNATIONAL FEET TO U.S. SURVEY FEET MULTIPLY BY 0.999998.

CONTROL POINTS FOR THIS SURVEY WERE NOT SET ON AND DO NOT REPRESENT PROPERTY LINES OR RIGHT OF WAY LINES AND ARE INTENDED FOR USE BY JACKSON COUNTY ROADS, PARKS AND PLANNING SERVICES AND OBEC CONSULTING ENGINEERS IN SUPPORT OF FUTURE PROJECTS. IT IS NOT THE INTENT OF JACKSON COUNTY ROADS, PARKS AND PLANNING SERVICES OR OBEC CONSULTING ENGINEERS TO PERPETUATE THESE CONTROL POINTS AS MONUMENTS.

THE CONTROL SURVEY WAS PERFORMED IN JUNE OF 2004. THE SURVEY EQUIPMENT CONSISTED OF TWO TRIMBLE 4700 RECEIVERS, A TRIMBLE 4400 RECEIVER, TWO TSCI DATA COLLECTORS, AND A NIKON DTM-520 TOTAL STATION.

DEAD INDIAN MEMORIAL ROAD


THE RETRACEMENT OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF DEAD INDIAN MEMORIAL ROAD WAS COMPLETED UTILIZING: DEAD INDIAN MARKET ROAD NO.6 (POMPADOUR SECTION) DRAWING, DATED MA/ 1910; VOLUME 170, PAGE 513, JACKSON COUNTY DEED RECORDS; INSTRUMENT NO. 85-06540, JACKSON COUNTY DEED RECORDS AND MARNEST APPLEGATE PETITION SURVEY SHOWING DEAD INDIAN ROAD, DATED JANUARY 1917. ALSO USED WERE FILED SURVEY NO'S: 3973, 13010, 12760, 4016, 2470, 5058, 4297, 3645, 4462, 15329, 7182 & 4366.

IN THE 1917 ORDER ESTABLISHING ROAD, THE ROAD WIDTH FOR DEAD INDIAN MEMORIAL ROAD WAS STATED TO BE 40 FEET WIDE AND FOLLOWED THE COURSES AS SURVEYED IN THE PETITION SURVEY. BY HOLDING SURVEYED TIES SHOWN ON THE PETITION SURVEY TO THE "L" CORNER OF DLC 52 & 53 AND THE SECTION CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 1, 6, 7 & 12, THE CENTERLINE WAS FOUND TO HAVE A RESULTING ERROR MISCLOSURE OF 0.98 OF A FOOT. THE ALIGNMENT WAS ADJUSTED BY THE COMPASS RULE ADJUSTMENT METHOD TO FIT WITH THE CONTROLLING MONUMENTS.


VOLUME 170, PAGE 513, FILED IN 1929 COVERS RIGHT OF WAY DEEDED FROM "MR" 0+00 TO THE NORTH. THE DEED DESCRIBES A 60 FOOT STRIP OF LAND DEEDED TO JACKSON COLNTY FOR RIGHT OF WAY PURPOSES AND REFERS TO THE DEAD INDIAN MARKET ROAD NO. 6 (POMPADOUR SECTION) RIGHT OF WAY DRAWING FOR ALIGNMENT CONTROL. FILED SURVEY NO'S 3973, 7182, 13010, 12760, 4016 & 2470 REFERENCE OLD CENTERLINE P.I.'S AND MONUMENTS SET BY THE COUNTY FOR ALIGNMENT CONTROL MONUMENTS THAT WERE TIED ON THESE SURVEYS FIT WELL WITH THE RESOLVED RIGHT OF WAY.

SOUTH OF BEAR CREEK, IN INSTRUMENT NO. 85-06540, THE COUNTY PURCHASED ADDITIONAL RIGHT OF WAY BETWEEN STATIONS "RW" 8+95.34 TO "RW" 43+31.86. FOUND MONUMENTS PER JACKSON COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS RIGHT OF WAY MONUMENTATION MAP (UNRECORDED) WERE COMPARED TO RECORD HORIZONTA_ ALIGNMENT AND RIGHT OF WAY WIDTHS CALLED OUT IN THE DEED. THE RESIDUALS BETWEEN THE RECORD RIGHT OF WAY WID HS TO FOUND MONUMENTS WAS EXCESSIVE AND THEREFORE THESE MONUMENTS WERE NOT HELD. THE LINE COMMON TO D_C'S 52 & 53 WAS HELD PER THE DEED TO CONTROL THE CENTERLINE AND RIGHT OF WAY.

THE HATCHED AREA ON SHEET 4 OF 6, NORTH OF BRIDGE NO. 37, SHOWS A GAP BETWEEN THE RIGHT OF WAYS DETAILED IN VOLUME 170, PAGE 513 AND 1917 ORDER ESTABLISHING ROAD. AFTER EXTENSIVE RESEARCH OF RECORDS, NO RIGHT OF WAY DOCUMENTATION WAS FOUND TO EXIST AT THE LOCATION OF BRIDGE NO. 37.










AND RETRACEMENT MAP DEAD INDIAN MEMORIAL ROAD @ EMIGRANT CREEK FOR JACKSON COUNTY








