

LOCATION:

Block 'P' of the Railroad Addition to the Town of Ashland in the Northwest Quarter of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, City of Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To replace a property corner monument which was removed during construction of a sidewalk.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

True meridian at the north-south centerline of Section 9 as derived from the N.O.A.A. survey net on file in the Office of the Jackson County Surveyor. The reference for bearing control for this survey was taken from Filed Survey No. 6478.

PROCEDURE:

The property corner to be reestablished is at the northeast corner of the intersection of East Main Street and Lithia Way. Originally, it was set in 1966 by J.A Hoffbuhr as part of Filed Survey No. 3394. Mr. Hoffbuhr used the monuments at Fifth and Sixth Street along with a spike found at Fourth Street to establish the centerline of East Main. The survey and narrative do not describe how the location of Lithia Way was determined. In Survey No. 4267, Mark Boyden found a sandstone with a drill hole at the intersection of Fourth Street and East Main and replaced it with a pipe and brass cap in a monument case. The location appears to differ slightly from the location of the spike found by Hoffbuhr. In Survey No. 6478, Everett Swain revisited the subject of Lithia Way's location. In his narrative, Mr. Swain discusses his evaluation of the deed record location of the right of way with the physical location of the street. Because of conflicts between the deed record location and existing structures, Mr. Swain accepted the physical location of the street. A subsequent survey in this area (No. 16099) also accepted Mr. Swain's work.

For this survey, I held Mr. Swain's location for Lithia Way and used the monuments at Fourth Street and the angle point to the west for the centerline of East Main.


