

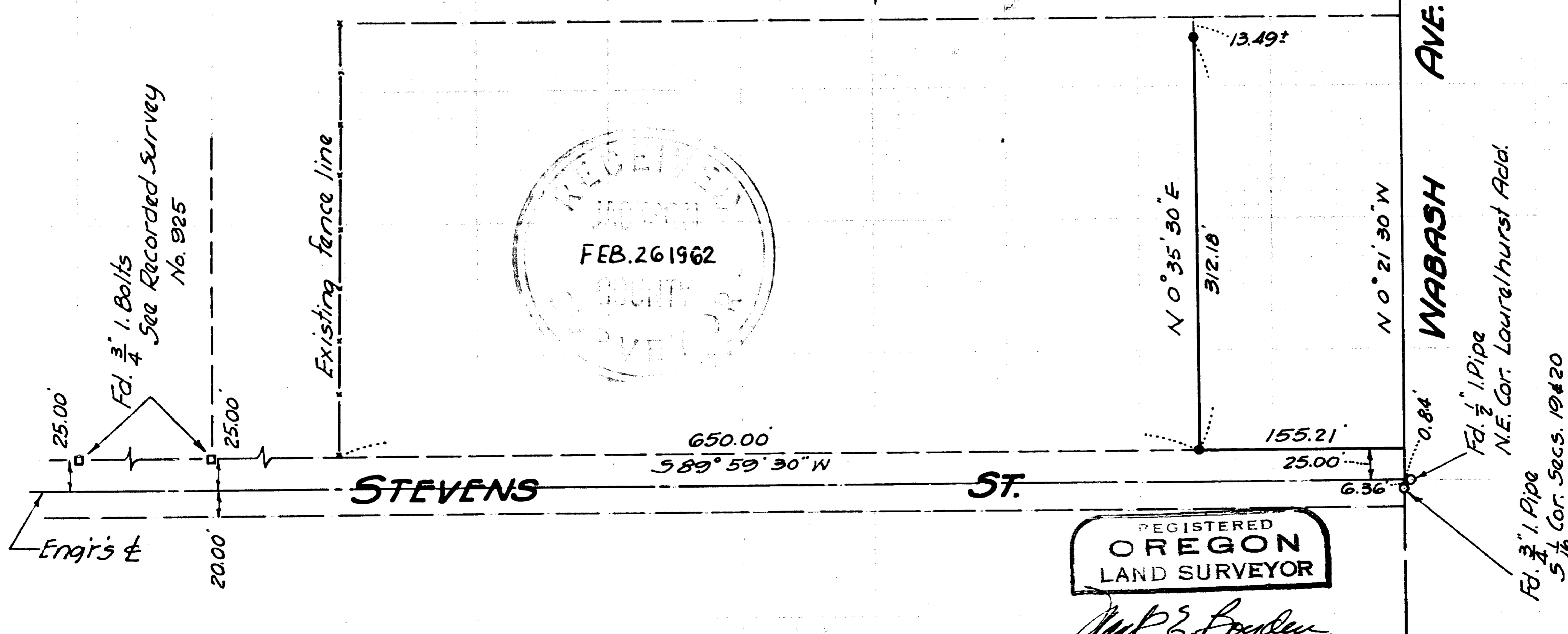
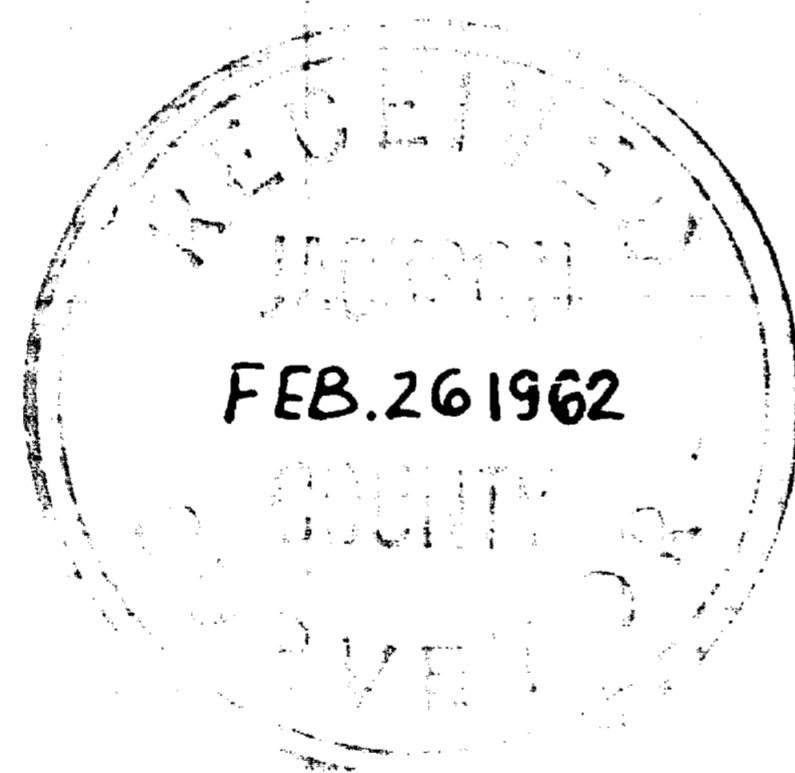

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: George E. Lanning  
661 Wabash Avenue  
Medford, Oregon

PURPOSE: To monument a division line within the Lanning property described in Volume 273, Page 47 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon

Also prepare a description of the remaining parcel lying East of said division line, using a more-or-less distance to and along the South boundary of the adjoining tract described in Volume 238, Page 20 of the Deed Records.

PROCEDURE:

Found street and section line control monuments as shown.

Monumented said division line with 5/8" iron pins, setting the most-Northerly pin well back from the existing East-West fence line for line control only.

Bearings based on the Meridian of solar origin reported on Survey No. 925.
