


PURPOSE: To monument the adjusted Easterly boundary line of a conservation easement as depicted on the map, per my clients request.

PROCEDURE: I tied the Quarter corner common to Sections 19 and 20 along with iron rods set on filed survey 13115 and 18433. I then set monuments at the newly adjusted corners of the Easterly boundary of conservation easement per my client's instructions. Legal descriptions were prepared for the area within the conservation easement and an ingress-egress easement through the conservation easement, over the existing asphalt driveway accessing a new home site on Tax
