SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: TO SURVEY AND MONUMENT THAT TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED IN INSTRUMENT NO. 99-54555 OF THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON.

PROCEDURE: UTILIZING AN ELECTRONIC LEICA TCRA 1103 ROBOTIC TOTAL STATION AND RANGING PRISMS, I SURVEY THE MONUMENTS AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT. THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IS BOUNDED ON THE WEST BY THE EAST LINE OF TOLMAN CREEK ROAD AND BOUNDED ON THE EAST BY THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST HALF OF THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 14. THE SOUTH LINE OF SUBJECT PROPERTY LIES ON A LINE BRING 1094 50 FRET NORTHERLY OF AND PARALLEL WITH THE SOUTH BEING 1094.50 FEET NORTHERLY OF AND PARALLEL WITH THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 14, WITH THE NORTH LINE BEING 70.00
NORTHERLY FROM AND PARALLEL WITH SAID SOUTH LINE.
SURVEYOR GEORGE BURRELL HAD SUBDIVIDED THE SOUTHWEST
QUARTER OF SECTION 14 IN THE PERFORMANCE OF SURVEY NO. 9780, AND IN THE PROCESS, ALSO SURVEYED THE RIGHT OF WAY OF TOLMAN CREEK ROAD. MONUMENTS RECOVERED FROM SURVEY NO. 6780 FIT VERY WELL AGAINST THE SURVEY RECORD AND WERE HELD FOR POSITION. THE DEED RECORD DISTANCES OF 1094.50 FEET AND 70.00 FEET WERE THEN HELD TO LAYOUT THE SOUTH & NORTH LINES
