SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

For: Michael DeHaas, et-al 1856 Ross Lane Medford, OR. 97501

Location: Southwest one-quarter of Section 25, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

Purpose: To monument the boundary of the lands described within deed document 03-035668.

Procedure: I began this survey with the recovery of previously established corner monuments established by C.Z. Boyden subdivision of Section 25 (circa 1947), Filed Survey No. 1525 performed by Charles H. Hurst , L.S. No. 483 and Filed Survey No. 6454 performed by Edward McGinty, L.S. 501.

Deed descriptions of my client property, adjacent properties and the Resolution and Order (Reference 363-79, 79-14554) establishing a portion of West Gregory Road and the public portion of Harold Road were prepared from the above surveys.

Surveyor McGinty indicates within the Narrative for Filed Survey No. 6454 his survey to be dependant on Filed Survey No. 1525 and for some reason unknown to this surveyor set the corners of that survey 0.20 feet "plus or minus to the westerly". I performed a search for McGinty monuments and recovered only the northwest corner monument. The remaining monuments were not recovered and appear to have been destroyed by fence construction.

Deed descriptions of the East boundary line of the parcels situated along Harold Road indicate a bearing of North 00° 05′ 49″ West. A review of Filed Survey No.10321, performed by Verlyn D. Thomas, L.S. 505, indicates lines to the North from Gibbon Road were established parallel to the North-South Centerline of Section 25 (angle of 90° 15′ 51″ indicated on the Thomas map of survey). My review of Filed Survey No.1525 performed by Hurst indicates an angle of 90° 16′ 00″ and 90° 17′ 49″ for the lines bearing to the North from Gibbon Road. The bearings shown by Hurst were determined by the sectional subdivision corners of Section 25. I tied to the fence corners along this line and after evaluation of the alignment concluded that an angle of 90° 16′ 04″ provided an alignment that matched improvements and essentially matched the Hurst angle for the East line of Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter Section 25.

The East line of Harold Road was determined from document 79-14554 containing a description prepared by McGinity. The computed location matched improvements along the East and West lines of Harold Road. The North and South lines were established East-West as called within document 70-12088.

Equipment utilized in performance of this survey: Nikon DTM 420 Electronic Total Station and related support equipment.


