Survey Narrative, to comply with paragraph 209,250 ORS.

Survey for Faydrex, Inc., 843 East Main St., Medford, Oregon.

lurpose: To survey "Valley Home Acres" being the North half of Section 13, T358, R2W, WM, and to divide into 60 parcels.

rocedure: Survey was started March 16th, 1962. Solar observation was made. The reestablished corner of Section 11, 12, 13 and 14 was found, being a 2" iron pipe, 6" underground.

36" white oak bears N 19" W

304.8 feet

34" white oak bears N 55° E

147.2 feet

14" white oak bears S 46 1/2° W

3/4" iron pipe bears S 0°11' W

40.0 feet

Thence running on a true line, South 89°53' East, 1/2 mile and failed to find the 1/4 corner between Sections 12 and 13; thence South 89°53' East 5299.19 feet (from the NW corner of Section 13) and found the NE corner of Section 13. This had previously been been observed, making it possible to run on a true line. I returned to the 1/4 corner between Sections 12 and 13, which is recorded as being reestablished on single proportionate distance. I found the two bearing trees but could not find the reestablished corner or the two witness pins. Since this reestablished corner would lie on a straight line between the two section corners, it is not an essentail corner in this survey. I returned to the NE corner of Section 13, where I had found a 2" iron pipe, extending 1 foot above ground at the Section corner on Range line for Sections 12. 13 (T355,R2W) and Sections 7, 18 (T355,R1W)

12" white oak bears N 40 $1/2^{\circ}$ E 302.4 feet 14" white oak bears S 78 $1/4^{\circ}$ e 468.2 feet

Thence running on a true line, South 0006 East along the center line of Beagle Road, 2648.4 feet and found the 1/4 corner on the Range line, Section 13 (2355, R2W) and Section 18 (2355, R1W), Found

1" iron pipe, set ô" underground 3/4" iron pipe bears East 40.0 feet 5/8" iron pipe bears West 40.0 feet

Thence running on a true line, North 89°50'06" West to the 1/4 corner of Sections 13 and 14, the distance being 5301.34 feet.

Found a sandstone with X mark on top.

8" twin white oak bears 5 43°30' W 62.0 feet

36" white oak bears N 25°30' W 159.7 feet

20" white oak bears N 59°15' E 440.0 feet

Thence running on a true line North 0°02' West 2644.0 feet to the Section corner 11, 12, 13, 14, as above described.

These points were used as a base for the survey and monuments were set for the 60 parcels, as shown on the accompanying map.
