SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

PURPOSE: Perform a boundary survey and prepare a Final Plat pursuant to Client's instructions and as approved by the City of Central Point Planning Commission, Resolution Number 593.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing Trimble 5700 Global Positioning System (GPS), Trimble 5600 and S-6 robotic instruments, and Trimble TSCe data collectors with Trimble Survey Controller Software, all found monuments were tied via closed traverses or by redundant ties. Records utilized were: Document Number Ol-42284 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon; Surveys Numbered 708, 11902, 16648, 19077, and Roll Map Number V-16/4, as filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor; the record plats of SNOWY BUTTE ORCHARDS, and SNOWY BUTTE STATION, PHASE 2 (recorded February 22, 2006, in Volume 32 of Plats at Page 14 of the Records of Jackson County, Oregon, and filed as Survey Number 19077 in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor).

Basis of bearings is referenced to Geodetic North per Survey Number 19077, a survey previously performed by this firm.
